Sir,

This is in reference to the Administrative Approval with no. 11/7/2015-EFM, dated 30.09.2015 for National Clean Energy Fund (NCEF) support for creation of Intra-State Transmission System in the State of Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu under Green Energy Corridor project.

2. The first line be read as:

“I am directed to convey sanction of the President for providing NCEF support of Rs.4056.67 crore for creation of intra-state transmission system in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Rajasthan in a span of 5 years from 2015-16 to 2019-20, and in the State of Tamil Nadu in a span of 3 years from 2014-15 to 2016-17, under the Green Energy Corridor project.”

instead of

“for creation of intra-state transmission system in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu in a span of 5 years from 2015-16 to 2019-20.”

3. In continuation of the above, I am also directed to convey the sanction of the President for extension of the commissioning time line for the creation of intra-state transmission system in the State of Tamil Nadu by two years, i.e. up to 31.03.2019. The Implementing Nodal Department of the State of Tamil Nadu is directed to complete the project within the said extension in all the aspects, including submission of three months performance

testing and certification of synchronization of grid so as to complete the project financially, latest by 31.03.2019.

4. This sanction issues in exercise of powers delegated to this Ministry and with the approval of competent authority and concurrence of IFD vide their Diary. No. 600 dated 31.10.2017.

Annexure-II

The terms & condition for release of NCEF support to the States of Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu for creation of intra-state transmission system in under Green Energy Corridor project

1. The States to ensure that the intra-state transmission system developed from NCEF support caters to the renewable energy projects.
2. The release of NCEF support will be linked to the progress and the respective State Transmission Utility will submit physical and financial progress report in respect of the NCEF support released for the project to enable subsequent release of NCEF support.
3. Respective State Transmission Utilities to submit monthly progress report of the project in the format prescribed to the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy.
4. The State to ensure that transmission capacity is not left unutilised.
