Subject: Strict compliance of rules and regulations in procurement of Goods and Services – Reg.

It is observed that recently few government agencies in Renewable Energy sector in August 2025 have issued bids with very less window for bid submission, as low as 7 days for procurement. This seems to have been issued clearly to circumvent the ALMM for cells mandate of MNRE.

- 2. As you are aware that all REIAs/PSUs/ other Government tender issuing agencies are required to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations issued by the Ministry of Finance and Central Vigilance Commission, time to time, in matters related to public procurement for maintaining financial propriety and transparency.
- 3. Accordingly, all agencies are requested to strictly comply with the existing rules and regulations when issuing bids for procurement. Any existing bids with short bidding timelines, which have been issued without complying with the existing GFR rules and CVC regulations may be scrapped, if required and new bids may be issued with full compliance to the extant provisions. Action taken in this regard may be reported back within 15 days positively.
- 4. This is issued with the approval of competent authority.
