**Subject: Amendment in the Implementation Guidelines of New Solar Power Scheme (for Tribal and PVTG Habitations/Villages) under PM JANMAN and DA JGUA.**

This is in reference to the Implementation Guidelines of the New Solar Power Scheme (for Tribal and PVTG Habitations/Villages) under PM JANMAN and DA JGUA, issued vide Order of even number dated 18.10.2024, and subsequent amendments.

2. In this regard, the Implementation Guidelines are amended as follows with immediate effect:

S. No.	Existing provision	Amended provision
1	<b>10.2</b> The implementing agency shall obtain a performance bank guarantee (BG) of 10% of the award amount from the Vendor with a validity during the R&M period of 5 years. In case R&M services are not provided by the Vendor or the systems are not working properly, the BG may be encashed to repair or replace the systems as may be required and the implementing agency will have the right to blacklist the Vendor for all future renewable energy project tenders.	<b>10.2</b> The implementing agency shall obtain a suitable performance bank guarantee (BG) in accordance with GFR rules (as amended from time to time), from the Vendor with a validity during the R&M period of 5 years. In case R&M services are not provided by the Vendor or the systems are not working properly, the BG may be encashed to repair or replace the systems as may be required and the implementing agency will have the right to blacklist the Vendor for all future renewable energy project tenders.
