To facilitate smooth and easy access to the persons approaching the department for dealing different matters.

Mission:-

- a) To enforce the Excise Laws & Rules to check violation of various provisions of Goa, Daman & Diu Excise Duty Act, 1964 by any licensee.
- b) And to see that there is no evasion of Excise Duty.

i) Functions & Duties.

To regulate the production, Sale and collection of revenue on excisable goods within the Union Territory of Daman & Diu and to check and supervise the process of manufacture sale and collection of duty and proper functioning of all the distilleries, breweries and licensed vendors of wholesale and retail sale of liquor in the territory as well as import/export of the said excisable goods from the territory.

The Department is dealing mainly with the work related to license holders of Distilleries/Breweries/Wholesale licenses/Retail Licenses for manufacture & Sale of Liquor respectively as per Goa, Daman & Diu Excise Duty Act & Rules, 1964.

Issue of Licenses for retail sale of IMFL & CL to 'A' & 'B' Category Hotels

- a) Renewal of all kinds of licenses every year thereby collecting the requisite license fee.
- b) Issue of permission for import and sale of Foreign Liquor to the existing licensee on payment of prescribed fee.

(ii) The powers and duties of its officers and employees :-

- a) The powers under the Goa, Daman & Diu Excise Duty Act, 1964 is vested in the Commissioner of Excise. He can delegate his powers to the subordinates Officers/Officials to discharge various functions of the Excise Act in force.
