The auction of above Condemned Vehicles will be “AS IS WHERE IS BASIS” and interested party can inspect the Vehicles on working days during office hours after obtaining permission from the Director, Medical & Health Services, D&D. The Auction notice may be downloaded from <http://www.daman.nic.in>.
2. The bidder must submit application as per attached Annexure along with a copy of their PAN Card Number, residential proof i.e. Ration Card, Voter ID Card, etc without which no bid will be entertained.

3. Interested bidders would have to submit EMD for Rs.1000/- (Rs. One Thousand Only) for each bid. The EMD shall be refunded back to the unsuccessful bidder after the auction process is completed.
4. The successful bidder has to deposit 50% of the offered bid on the spot. The successful bidder will deposit the balance amount within 07 days . The auctioned vehicle will be handed over to the successful bidder(s) only after receiving the entire amount. EMD will be adjusted with the final value.
5. The bidder(s) may bid for single or multiple items and accordingly has to submit EMD.
6. The sold vehicle will be removed by the successful bidder(s) within 7 days of the date of auction.
7. If the successful bidders fail to deposit the quoted price within one week from date of auction, his bid will be cancelled and the entire amount i.e., EMD as well as Bid Security Money will be forfeited.
8. An offer shall be considered as highest and final, only if the amount of bid offered by the bidder is announced consequently three times uninterrupted.
9. The successful bidder shall have to lift the auctioned vehicles within three days after depositing 50% of remaining offered bid amount from the date of finalization of the auction by submitting documentary evidence in support of residential status (Ration Card/ Voters Identity card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.).
10. The vehicle will be sold on “As is where is” basis and the principle of caveat emptor (let the buyer be aware) will apply. “As is where is” means that the description / quality indicated are approximate and the seller does not give any assurance or guarantee that the material will strictly adhere to the advertisement. All items shall be taken delivery of from the site by the successful bidder, with its faults and error in description, if any. Neither can the sale be invalidated nor the bidder(s) make any claim(s)/compensation, whatsoever, on account of any defect in description or deficiency in the quantity and quality. No plea of misunderstanding or ignorance of conditions put forth subsequent to a confirmation of sale shall be accepted.
11. The interested bidder(s) may be provided the opportunity to inspect the vehicle(s) during office hours before participating in the auction process.
12. EMD of unsuccessful bidder will be returned within 30 days of after completion of all formalities of the auction and the Bidder will collect the EMD from the Office of DMHS.

13. In case of any default in lifting of the vehicle(s) by the buyer within the prescribed time limit (as per clause 5), payment of ground rent @ 1 % of the offered price per day shall be paid by the buyer to the Directorate of Medical and Health Services, Daman.
14. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the registration certificate of the Condemned Vehicles transferred in his name at his own cost expeditiously; this office will not be responsible for any lapse in this regard.
15. The fancy Registration number(s) will not be given to the bidder(s) and the bidder(s) has to register the sold vehicle(s) as per Motor Vehicle Act-1988 with concerned transport authority.
16. The Government reserves the right to reject all or any offer in whole or part without assigning any reasons thereof.

Dispute, if any, shall be subject to Daman jurisdiction only.
