### AUTHORIZATION FOR HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTES

1. Authorization No. PCC/DDD/(9, 5191/HW/BP)10.11/305 dated:- 01/02/15
2. **M/s Shakai Packaging P. Ltd.**, is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for following hazardous wastes on the premises at **Sr. No. 342/3(77), Village Bhimpore, Daman.**
3. The authorization is granted to operate a facility for collection, storage, transport and disposal of hazardous waste as mentioned below.
4. The authorization shall be in force for a period upto **31/05/2020**.
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and to such conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

**Terms and Conditions of Authorization**

- The authorizations shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and Hazardous Wastes Management and Handling Rules, 1989 and amendments made there under. In case of failure to comply with the terms, the authorizations and consent orders issued under Water and Air Acts shall be revoked without any notice or hearing.
- The authorizations or its renewals shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the Pollution Control Committee.
- The authorizations shall not mix, send, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous wastes without observing the provisions of the Pollution Control Committee.
- Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the authorizations shall constitute a breach of the authorization.
- It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the Pollution Control Committee to close down the unit.
- The application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made as laid down in rule 5 (6) (i).
- The applicant shall submit annual return to Pollution Control Committee regarding disposal of Hazardous Wastes as per Hazardous Wastes Management and Handling Rules, 1989 and amendments thereof.
- The applicant shall submit steps taken, wherever feasible, for reduction in the waste generated or recycled or reused.
- The applicant shall manage Hazardous Wastes in an environmentally sound manner so as not to cause any damage to the surrounding environment.
- The authorization shall be suspended or cancelled if in the opinion of the Pollution Control Committee, the authorized person fails to comply with any of the conditions of the authorization or with any provisions of the Hazardous Wastes Management and Handling Rules, 1989 and amendments thereof.
- The applicant shall ensure that the hazardous wastes are packed in a manner suitable for handling, storage and transportation.
- Packaging, sealing and transport of hazardous wastes shall be in accordance with the provisions of the rules made under the Radioactive Act, 1980 and other guidelines issued from time to time.
- The hazardous waste container shall be provided with a general label as given in Form 8 of Hazardous Wastes Management and Handling Rules, 1989 and amendments thereof.
- The applicant shall provide the transporter (of hazardous wastes) with six copies of the manifest (Form 9) as per the colour code. The transporter shall give a copy of the manifest signed and dated to the applicant and retain the remaining copies as to meet as prescribed in sub-rule (5).
- The applicant shall provide the transporter with relevant information in Form 10 regarding the hazardous nature of the wastes and measures to be taken in case of an emergency.
- The applicant shall obtain necessary inter-state certificate from State Pollution Control Boards or Pollution Control Committees in the respective states involved in case of any inter and intra State transport of hazardous wastes.
- The applicant is permitted to sell the hazardous wastes or materials only to those who obtained authorization from the State Pollution Control Boards or Pollution Control Committees in the respective states to use the said material as raw materials. The documents in this regard shall be submitted to the Pollution Control Committee before selling the materials.
- The applicant shall maintain records of collection, reception, treatment, transport, storage and disposal of Hazardous Wastes as Form 3 of Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 1989 amendments thereof.
- The movement of hazardous wastes from or to the country shall be considered illegal (i) if it is without prior permission of the Central Government; or (ii) if the permission has been obtained through falsification, mis-representation or fraud; or (iii) if it goes against the shipping details provided in the document.
- The applicant shall apply to Pollution Control Committee for importing hazardous/recyclable wastes as raw materials in Form 4 of Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 1989 and amendments thereof.
- The applicant is not permitted to export Hazardous Wastes without the prior permission of Govt. of India.
- The applicant shall be liable (i) for damages caused to the environment resulting due to improper handling and disposal of hazardous wastes, (ii) to restore or restore damaged or destroyed elements of the environment & (iii) to pay a fine as per to Pollution Control Committee for any violation of the provisions under Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 1989 and amendments thereof.
- The authorizer shall inform the member of the TSDF located at Sr. No. 91, at Village Mota Randha, Silvassa operated by SAI. Dated within thirty days from the date of the issue and submit the copy of the same to the PCC, Daman. If fail to comply the same the authorization shall be revoked.
- The authorizer shall dispose their waste to TSDF facility only located at above place.
