

M/s. A. R. Polyprint, Village Dabhel, Daman was issued 'consent to establish' to manufacture bio-degradable bags, polythene bags-200 MTPA (by way of printing-cutting-sealing-punching only) under Water/Air Act and valid upto 30/06/2015. The activity falls under **Green Category**. The unit has applied for 'operate consent' on 26/02/2015 under Water/Air Act and the following documents are as under:

- Application Form-XIII under Water Act.
- Application Form-I under Air Act.
- Paid consent fees of Rs. 400/- under Water Act & Air Act.
- Declaration letter regarding capital investment.
- Establishment consent copy under Water Act & Air Act.
- Application Form-I for authorization to handle hazardous wastes and industry data sheet.
- Details of display sign board.
- Form-I application for registration for manufacturing of plastic carry bags and containers.

The unit was inspected on 10/03/2015 and the observations are as under:

- The unit was in operation at the time of inspection.
- The unit has installed machinery such as printing m/c, bottom sealing m/c-4 Nos., punching m/c and weigh scale.
- The unit is installed the plant & machinery to the above manufacture the items.
- The process includes mainly by RMs (ready rolls)-printing-cutting & sealing-punching-packing.
- The unit has installed displayed sign board.
- The unit is not using any water during the process and is not significant to pollution potential.

In view of the above, the 'operate consent' (**Green Category**) to manufacture bio-degradable bags, polythene bags-200 MTPA (by way of printing-cutting-sealing-punching only) under Water/Air Act may be issued with a terms and conditions as mentioned in Annexure-I & II.
