

M/sBhim Polyfab Industries (Unit-4), Dabhel, Daman was issue Consent to Establish for manufacturing of “1) HDPE/PP woven fabrics laminated/unlaminated, HDPE/PP woven bags/sacks/jumbo bags laminated/unlaminated, HDPE/PP woven bags/sacks with/without liner, HDPE/PP outside laminated perforated bags/box bags, clear sheets, ROTO gravure BOPP printed sandwich bags, flexible intermediated bulk container with/without liner, PP RP granules, HDPE/PP tarpaulin, Jumbo bags – 15000 MTPA 2) Polyester texturised yarn and Twisted yarns, Polyester texturised nylon spun doubling yarn & nylon texturised twisted yarn – 10000 MTPA” under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 which was valid upto **31/07/2017**. The activity falls under **Category – III**.

The unit has submitted application for grant of Consent to Operate on 26/07/2017 with following documents:

- Application form. XIII under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.
- Application form. I under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
- Consent fees of Rs. 2,40,000/-.
- Declaration letter for details of capital investment.
- Copy of consent to Establish.
- Display signboard.
- Form – I for application for authorization to handle Hazardous Waste.
- Industry Data Sheet Format.

The unit was inspected on 10/08/2017 in presence of Mr. Ashok Zavar and at the time of inspection following observations were noted:

- Display signboard was installed outside of the premises.
- The unit was in operation at the time of inspection.
- Raw material used in manufacturing process was PP/HDPE granules, printing ink, liner sheet, master batch, stitching threads.
- Products being manufactured were Plastic woven fabric and bags/sacks (laminated/unlaminated), Box bag/sacks, Polyester and nylon texturised/twisted yarn .
- Manufacturing process involved at the time of inspection was Extrusion, winding, weaving, printing, cutting, stitching, texturising and twisting of yarn.
- Machineries installed within the premises of the unit were Extrusion m/c – 03 no, Circular loom – 50 no, Printing m/c – 03 no, Lamination plant – 02 no, cutting and stitching m/c – 30 no, Bale press m/c – 03 no, Texturising and twisting plant – 01 no.
- The generated plastic waste were stored within the premises and sent to other unit for recycling.
