

M/s. Parvati Engineering Works, Dabhel, Daman was issue Consent to Establish for manufacturing of "Machinery, Machinery parts, SS/MS furniture and other equipment – 5000 Nos./Annum" which is valid upto **31/08/2017**. The activity falls under **Category – III**.

The unit has submitted application for Consent to Operate on 02/01/2017 with following documents:

- Application form no. XIII under Water Act.
- Application form no. I under Air Act.
- Consent fees of Rs. 15000/-.
- Declaration giving details of capital investment including land, building and plant & machinery without description.
- Copy of consent to establish obtained under Water and Air Act.
- Display sign board.
- Form – I for Application for authorization to handle Hazardous Waste.
- Industry Data Sheet Format.
- Manufacturing process with flow diagram.


The unit was inspected on ²⁴~~09~~/01/2017 and at the time of inspection following observations were noted:

- Display signboard was installed at the main gate.
- The unit was in operation at the time of inspection.
- Raw material used in manufacturing process was Steel/Copper/Aluminium/Brass plates, sheets, and rods of different grade.
- Products being manufactured at the time of inspection were Parts of machineries and Furniture for industrial use.
- Manufacturing process involved at the unit was cutting - drilling – grinding – milling – shaping - polishing.
- Machineries installed within the premises of the unit were Lath m/c – 5 no, Drill m/c – 2 no, Milling m/c – 1 no, Slotting m/s – 1 no, Sheet shearing m/c – 1 no, CNC m/c – 1 no.
- The unit is not significant to pollution potential as there is no water used during any stage of process and no significant emission form the process.

In view of above, if approved Consent to Operate (Category-III) for manufacturing of "Machinery, Machinery parts, SS/MS furniture and other equipment – 5000 Nos./Annum" under water act and air act may be issue for the period upto **31/12/2017** may be issue.
