Subject: Publishing advertisement by States/UTs to implement meritcum means based scholarship scheme for the year 2011-12.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the merit-cum means based scholarship scheme is a centrally sponsored scheme launched in the year 2007. Under the scheme 20000 scholarships are awarded every year, in addition to the renewals to students from among the notified minority communities for pursuing professional and technical courses, at under-graduate and post-graduate levels, in institutions recognized by the appropriate authority.

- 2. Under Merit-cum means based scholarship scheme, there is no financial target. However, physical target in respect of 20000 fresh scholarships distributed every year has been fixed in accordance with State-wise population of minority communities. The State/UT-wise breakup of 20,000 fresh scholarships has been uploaded on the website of this Ministry. This should be taken as target in respect of states so far as fresh scholarships for the year 2011-12 are concerned.
- 3. It has been decided in the meeting held with States/UTs on 9th November, 2010 to implement the Online Scholarship Management System (OSMS) for Merit-cum means based scholarship scheme from the financial year 2011-12. The software has been developed by NIC and the 'Institute Module' of the software will be made operational for use in the 1st week of March, 2011. The site could be accessed after the software is launched, through the URL www.momascholarship.gov.in. A link to the site would also be made available in the website of Ministry i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. A separate communication is being sent to States/UTs conveying the user ID and password for updating the list of institutes on the OSMS.
- 4. Attention is drawn to para-vii of terms and conditions which states, "the State department will advertise the scheme every year latest by 31st March and receive the application through the concerned institutions."

- 5. The State Government is accordingly requested to publish advertisement inviting applications for the year 2010-13 by 31st March, 2011 and adhere to the following time line with regard to submission of proposals to this Ministry:-
 - (i) Advertisement by 31st March, 2011.
 - (ii) Submission of proposals to the Ministry of Minority Affairs by 31st August, 2011.
- 6. The State Government is also requested to mention in the advertisement the proposed switch from manual system to online system and to inform the applicants details about the website including the address of the website. Applicants may also be advised to take print-outs of the duly filled-in application forms, through OSMS, and to submit the same alongwith all supporting documents through their respective institutes.
- 7. While submitting the proposals all terms & conditions contained in the Scheme need to be followed. It may also be ensured that proposals are submitted alongwith utilization certificate in proper format in GFR-19 A.
- 8. With regard to renewal of scholarships, past experience indicates that many State Governments/UTs are not mentioning the year for which renewal is required. As per requirement, the renewal proposal should clearly indicate the year for which the renewal is being sought.
- 9. The State Governments/UT Administrations are also advised to indicate the status of disbursement of scholarships released in the year 2010-11. The State Governments/UT Administrations have to upload the list of students alongwith requiste details, who were given scholarship in the previous year, on their respective websites so that the same could be hyperlinked with the website of this Ministry. The above condition will be insisted upon from the next year for release of funds. Hence, failure to place the list of beneficiaries for the year 2010-11 may result in non-consideration of proposals.
