Under the Scheme, Scholarships are awarded to students from notified minority communities for pursuing professional and technical courses, at under-graduate and post-graduate levels in institutions recognized by the appropriate authority, who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian, from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2.50 Lakhs.

OSMS has been introduced from the year 2011-12. The site is accessed through the URL <u>www.momascholarship.gov.in</u>. A link to the site is also made available in the website of Ministry i.e. <u>www.minorityaffairs.gov.in</u>.

It is reiterated that only online applications under Marit-cum Means Based Scholarship scheme will be accepted from this year and no request for accepting Offline applications will be entertained.

In the meeting of Administrator's Advisory Committee on Minorities held on 26/12/2013, the Hon'ble Administrator has directed to the Secretary Education to set up help desks to provide assistance to desirous students for applying for scholarship online.
