NOTIFICATION

No. 7-15/EC/DD/2017: Whereas, the delimitation of the wards of Diu Municipal Council (DMC) was last notified on 16th March, 2007 by the Election Commissioner;

And, whereas, section 10 (1) of the Daman and Diu Municipalities (Amendment) Regulation, 1994 (hereinafter called the said Regulation) states that "for the purpose of election of Councillor, each municipal area shall be divided into single member wards in such manner that the population of each ward shall, so far as practicable, be the same throughout the Municipal area";

And, whereas, section 2 (36) of the said Regulation specifies that 'Population' means the population ascertained at the last preceding census of which the relevant figures have been published;

Given the latest population figures that have been published in 2011 Census by the Census Commission of India;

And, whereas, the UT Administration of Daman and Diu has not proposed any change in the limits of Diu Municipal Council and has retained thirteen seats for the Council that had hitherto been notified vide Notification No. 2/28/97-Elect/Diu-Fix/108 dated 18th February, 1997;

And, whereas, since there is no substantial increase in the decadal population (from 2001 to 2011) of Diu Municipal area and the UT Administration has decided not to change the limits of Diu Municipal Council, as mentioned in the foregoing paragraph, neither the UT Administration of Daman and Diu nor the political parties would like to have any changes

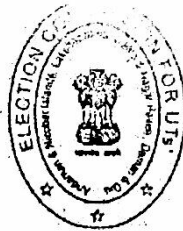

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) & (2) of section 10 of the Daman and Diu Municipalities (Amendment) Regulation, 1994, read with rule 3 (2) (a) of the Daman and Diu Municipalities (Elections) Rules, 1995, and keeping in view the sentiment of the public of Diu Municipal area and the view of the Administration and other relevant factors, such as, voter population as per the latest Parliamentary Electoral Roll revised and published in January, 2017, the Election Commission for the Union Territory of Daman and Diu, appointed under section 185 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayats) Regulation, 1994, proposes to keep the existing boundaries of wards of Diu Municipal Council as intact which were published on 16.03.2007 vide this Commission Order No. 7-15/EC/DD/2006 and publishes the same, as specified in the schedule appended to this notification, for inviting suggestions / objections in this regard by 31st March, 2017.

Any objection or suggestion thereto should be submitted to the under mentioned officers either personally or by other means between 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on all working days not later than 31st March, 2017. All suggestions or objections received after this date and time will not be considered:-

- (i) The Collector, Diu, Collectorate, Diu.
- (ii) The Chief Officer, Diu Municipal Council, Diu.

A detailed map showing the extent of each ward of Diu Municipal Council (DMC) shall remain available for inspection free of charge for the same period from the date of publication of this notification in the offices of the aforesaid officers and can additionally be accessed on www.daman.nic.in.

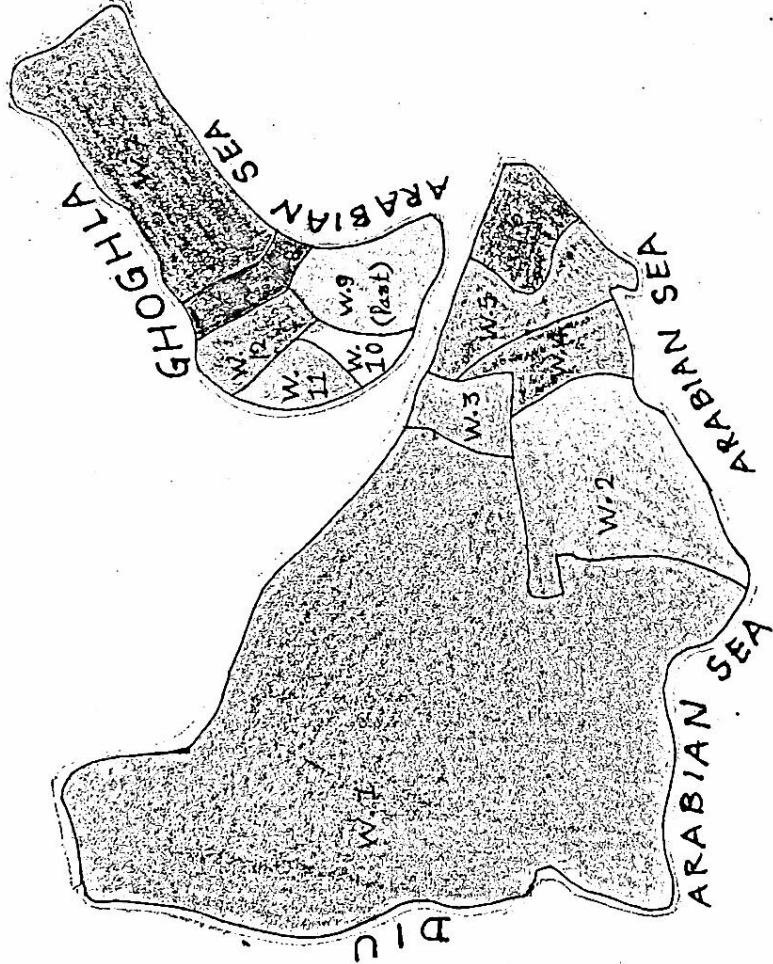
