17	IV.v	3% of the seats allotted will be reserved for Physically Handicapped students of U.T. of Daman & Diu (only for physically handicapped with the locomotor disorders and that too with disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% as per MCI regulation). The selection of such applicant is made as per disabilities conditions prescribed by Medical Council of India in its notification. In case of non availability of eligible applicants of PH category, the same seats will be filled-up from merit list of General category.	5% of the seats allotted will be reserved for applicant(s) (of U.T. of Daman & Diu) with disability. The selection of such applicant(s) is made as per disabilities conditions prescribed by Medical Council of India (MCI) or any other regularly in its notification time to time. In case of non availability of eligible applicants of PH category, the same seats will be filled-up from merit list of General category. 5% reservation for applicant(s) with disability has been proposed as per Notification of Ministry of Law and Justice dated 28/12/2016 para No.32(1), Stated that " All Governments Institutions of Higher Education and other Higher Education Institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five percent seats for persons with benchmark disabilities."
