Sub:- Criteria/Guidelines for Selection/Nomination of applicants against the Central Pool seats for Degree in Engineering / Architecture / Pharmacy courses as for the academic year 2023-24.

On the above cited subject, the following Criteria/Guidelines for Selection/Nomination of applicants against the Central Pool seats for Degree in Engineering / Architecture / Pharmacy courses as being allotted to the **Daman & Diu District** of Union Territory of DNH and Daman & Diu by Government of India for the academic year 2023-24 are notified and shall come into force with immediate effect:-

1 EARMARKING/ALLOCATION OF SEATS:-

1.1 Category wise allocation of seats for **Daman & Diu District** is given in Table-1 below. However the allocation is subject to change as per the directions of the Government of India/Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu:-

2. RESERVATION OF SEATS:-

- i. Persons belonging to reserved Category i.e. SC/ST/OBC/PWD are eligible for their claim on the reserved seats in the respective category as per 200 point Reservation (Local) Roster prepared by this Administration. **As per Reservation Policy of the UT Administration, 3% of the seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes (SC), 9% for Scheduled Tribes (ST), 27% for Other Backward Class (OBC) (Non-Creamy Layer) and 05% for Persons with Disability (PWD).**

- ii. Seats reserved for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates in Daman will be filled up only by candidates of the UT of DNH and Daman & Diu who are entitled to such reservations. Candidates who or their parents have migrated from other states to UT of DNH and Daman & Diu shall not be entitled to avail benefits of these seats.
- iii. The reservation as mentioned in sub-para (ii) above, can be interchanged. If sufficient number of applicants are not available to fill up seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes (ST), they may be filled up by suitable applicants from Scheduled Castes (SC) and vice versa. In case of non-availability of eligible applicants of SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS, the same seats will be filled-up by applicants of General Category.
- iv. The pattern of the Reservation as mentioned in the pre-paras (i) to (iii) above is as per the instructions issued by Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension, Department of Personnel & Training, New Delhi vide O.M. No. 36012/2/96-Estt(Res.) Dated 02/07/1997 and notification/ instructions issued time to time.

2.1 RESERVATION FOR PERSON WITH DISABILITIES:-

[2.1.1] 5% of total seats shall be reserved for persons with Physical Disability. As per Notification of Ministry of Law & Justice dated 28/12/2016 para No.32(1), Stated that “All Government Institutions of Higher Education and other Higher Education Institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five percent seats for persons with benchmark disabilities”. If the seats reserved for the persons with disabilities in a particular category remain vacant due to non-availability of candidates, such seats will be filled by the other candidates belonging to respective category only.

[2.1.2] For candidates coming under persons with disability (PWD) category, the minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out activities related to theory and practical's marks as applicable to B.E /B.Tech/ B.Arch. / B.Pharm. Courses.

[2.1.3] The proforma shall be signed by three members of Medical Authority duly constituted by the State or Central Government under persons with Disability (PWD) Act. One of the doctors in the Medical Authority shall be specialist in the particular field pertaining to the disability. The name, degree and specialization of all the doctors, date of issue shall be clearly visible in the certificate.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

For nomination to Central Pool Seats for Degree in Engineering / Architecture / Pharmacy courses allotted to the **Daman and Diu District** of U.T. Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu:-

- a) Applicants shall be a citizen of India.
- b) Applicants should have completed age of 17 years at the time of admission/on or before 31st December, 2023.
- c) Applicants should not have been convicted of any criminal offence.
- d) Benefits of selection/nomination against Central Pool Reserved seats of **Daman & Diu District** of this UT can be availed only once. Once applicants have given acceptance to his/her nomination, he/she shall not be eligible for any other course in the same year or in the subsequent year.
- e) If the seat allotted to the applicants in first round of the counseling is not as per his/her choice, he/she can opt for upgradation/change of the seat in the second round. The allotted/surrendered seat will be considered in the successive round of the counseling.
- f) The selection or nomination of the applicants will be made on the basis of the marks obtained by them in JEE conducted by NTA. As per communication received from MHRD F.No.19-1/2019-TC dated 17/04/2023, the qualification criteria for Engineering / Architecture & Pharmacy is as given below:-

3.1.1. For Engineering:

The candidate should have secured at least 45% marks in the 12th class examination, conducted by the respective Boards. For SC/ST candidates the qualifying marks would be 40% in the 12th Class examination, conducted by the respective boards.

3.1.2. For Architecture:

For Architecture, passed 10+2 examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in Aggregate of 10+2 level examination.

NOTE: Candidates seeking / expecting admission in B.Arch courses may be asked for NATA score (as prescribed by CoA), hence candidates are advised to get in touch with institute where they are expecting their allotment for any such additional requirement for admission.

3.1.3. For Pharmacy seats:

Allotment is to be done on the basis of aggregate percentage of class XII, and the candidate must have passed class XII with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology, Biotechnology and Computer.

4. PRIORITY IN ADMISSION:-

Applicants shall be considered for nomination in each category in the following order of priority:-

a) First priority:-

Applicants whose parents/guardians (in case Father and Mother are not alive) are Domicile of the Daman & Diu District of UT of DNH and Daman & Diu and the applicants has studied continuously from Class 8th to 12th in any of the recognized school of this UT.

b) Second priority:-

If the seats remain vacant after allotment of seats to applicants belonging to the first priority, then the applicants(s) whose parents/ guardian (in case Father and Mother are not alive) are Domicile of the **Daman & Diu District** of UT of DNH and Daman & Diu and applicants has studied in any recognized educational institution.

c) Third priority:

If the seats remain vacant even after allotment of seats to applicants falling in first and second priority, they will be offered to applicants whose parents/guardian (in case Father and Mother are not alive) are employees (regular/on deputation/on transfer) of the UT Administration/Central Government/UT PSUs/Central PSUs/ Nationalized Banks/Cooperative Banks and are posted in Daman & Diu continuously for the past 5 years as on the last date of application and the applicants have studied in a recognized school of Daman and Diu continuously from class 10th to 12th standard. In case of Bank Employees, their Headquarter shall be Daman or Diu.

d) Fourth priority

If the seats even remain vacant after allotment of seats to applicants falling in the First, Second and Third priority, then all the other eligible applicants will be considered in Fourth Priority.

5. MODE OF SELECTION FOR ENGINEERING/ARCHITECTURE/PHARMACY:-

5.1 CSAB-NEUT constituted by MOE, New Delhi will prepare the merit list which shall be on the basis of performance in Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Main conducted by NTA, New Delhi. All India Rank awarded to the applicant by NTA will be the basis for Selection / Nomination of applicants for courses of Engineering, Architecture.

5.2 The applicant must have passed the qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics for admission in B.E./ B.Tech. / Architecture courses as per the minimum qualification criteria as given under para 3.1.1 & 3.1.2.

5.3 The applicants intending to avail Architecture seats should qualify paper -II of JEE (Main) conducted by NTA, New Delhi.

5.4 Candidates applying for B. Pharmacy seats should qualify standard XII Board examination and the minimum qualification criteria is given under para 3.1.3.

5.5 The merit list for the pharmacy seats shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the Applicants in the class 12th Board Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics / Biology / Biotechnology & Computer (with practical Marks) for Admission in B. Pharmacy courses.

5.6 Guidelines for nomination in the sport round:- The spot round is allowed by Ministry of Education to fill up the vacant seats after completion of all rounds by CSAB-NEUT are as under:-

(i) The Validly registered applicant who fails to get any seat allotment in the scheduled rounds as per the schedule given by CSAB-NEUT will have to show their willingness in writing to be considered in the Spot Round. The applicant may show their willingness in writing for consideration in the spot round after the declaration of the result of the last round by CSAB-NEUT. The applicants will be called as per the merit list by the seats thus falling vacant after the scheduled rounds by CSAB-NEUT and will be considered for seat allotment in the SPOT ROUND.

(ii) The counseling committee will intimate the applicant and allotment of seats will be done on the basis of availability of vacant seats in the SPOT ROUND.

(iii) Applicant will have to appear in person before the counseling committee during the SPOT ROUND on the date prescribed by the Authority of the SPOT ROUND.

5.7 Selection / Nomination of applicants against central pool reserved seats for Diploma Courses to the Daman & Diu District which the prescribed minimum qualification is SSCE, shall be made as per Rules and Regulation approved to the Daman & Diu District by the Hon'ble Administrator of the DNH and Daman & Diu for the Government Polytechnic, Daman for admission to the Diploma Courses from time to time.

6. APPLICATION PROCEDURE:-

- i. The applicants desiring to avail the benefit of Central Pool reserved seats shall apply online as per the instructions of CSAB-NEUT published the advertisement for the Degree courses in Engineering / Architecture / Pharmacy courses by the Assistant Director (Tech. Education), of Daman & Diu District of U.T. Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu.
- ii. Information Brochure for Criteria / Guidelines shall be available on website CSAB-NEUT www.csab.nic.in/neut as well as also available on website of U.T. Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu <https://ddd.gov.in/> and Government Polytechnic, Daman website www.gpdaman.in.
- iii. The print copy of uploaded application along with the below listed documents / certificates should be submitted on or before prescribed date to the Assistant Director (Tech. Education), Government Polytechnic, Daman for registration and validation of counseling process. The applicant has to come personally with all original documents at reporting center for validation / Registration.
- iv. The name of the applicant must be the same in JEE Hall Ticket / JEE Score Card / XII Standard Mark Sheet and Online Registration in the CSAB-NEUT.
- v. Once the registration is validated by the Principal, Government Polytechnic, Daman within the prescribed time schedule, the applicant will be able to fill up the choice of courses.

[6.1] Documents / Certificates are to be attached with the print out of online registration done by the applicant for validation are as under:-

- i) Self attested copy of Mark Sheet of SSC Examination.
- ii) Self attested copy of Mark Sheet of HSSC Examination.
- iii) Self attested copy of Attempt Certificate of SSC/HSC Examination from School.
- iv) Self attested copy of School Leaving Certificate.

- v) Self attested copy of Schooling Certificate showing last 5 years studied (from 8th to 12th Std) of Schooling in the Schools of U.T. of DNH and Daman & Diu.
- vi) Domicile Certificate of Parents/Guardians issued by the Mamlatdar, Daman/Diu.
- vii) Service Certificate of parents from the Head of Office in case of applicants falling in third priority. In case of Bank employees, service certificate from the Regional Manager of the concerned bank shall be produced.
- viii) Self Attested copy of Caste Certificate for SC/ST/ OBC in the prescribed format from the Mamlatdar Daman/Diu.
- ix) Self Attested copy of Non-creamy Layer Certificate (For OBC applicant) issued after 1st April, 2022 shall be considered.
- x) Self Attested copy of JEE (Main) Competitive Examination Mark Sheet.
- xi) Self Attested copy of Dependent Certificate from Mamlatdar Daman / Diu.
- xii) Disability Certificate of applicant who is physically challenged from the Disability Assessment Board of Daman & Diu.
- xiii) Self Attested copy of Aadhar Card issued by the Competent Authority of India.

[6.2] HELP CENTER:

The Help Center for CSAB-NEUT will be set-up at Government Polytechnic, Daman. The following Officers will be In-charge of the help centers as under:-

- 1) Principal, Government Polytechnic, Daman
- 2) Principal, Government Polytechnic, Diu.

[6.3] Reporting Center:-

The reporting center for CSAB-NEUT will be set-up at Government Polytechnic, Daman (for applicants of the Daman & Diu). The following officers will be In-charge of reporting center.

- 1) Principal
Government Polytechnic, Daman ----- Center In Charge
- 2) Head of Department (Computer Engg.)
Govt. Polytechnic, Daman ----- Dy. Center In-Charge

7. COUNSELING COMMITTEE:-

[7.1] The Counseling Committee has been constituted to conduct spot round to fill up the vacant seats after completion of all rounds by CSAB- NEUT (from time to time) comprises of :-

1. Director (Higher & Technical Education), Daman & Diu----- Chairman.
2. Principal, Govt. Engineering College, Daman ----- Member.
3. Principal, Govt. College, Daman ----- Member.
4. A.D.E, District Panchayat, Daman ----- Member.
5. Principal, Govt. Polytechnic, Daman -----Member Secretary.

[7.2] The committee will finalize the list of applicants for nomination in Spot Round against the vacant seats for Engineering / Architecture / Pharmacy courses by counseling in the presence of the applicants.

[7.3] After selection of the applicant by Counseling Committee for the course as per his/ her choice, the applicant shall have to accept or reject the same before the Committee and in case of acceptance, he/she will have to pay a fees of Rs. 3000/- (Non-Refundable) immediately, thereafter the Agreement Bond and Surety Bond in prescribed Form (Appendix 'C' & 'D') are to be submitted to the Principal, Government Polytechnic, Daman, who shall issue Nomination letter to the selected applicant in the prescribed Form (Appendix 'E').

[8] The Counseling Committee shall be empowered to take decisions regarding eligibility of applicants, allocation of seats etc, and the decision of Counseling Committee shall be final in such matters.

[9] The whole criteria for selection will be on the basis of the qualifying merit prepared by CSAB NEUT for the applicants subject to any special orders issued with the concurrence of Government of India, MOE, New Delhi.

[10] While observing Criteria mentioned above, it should be kept in view that the selected applicant should also fulfill the admission requirements of respective College / State to which they are nominated as far as eligibility, minimum/maximum age (wherever prescribed) and minimum percentage of marks (wherever prescribed) are concerned.

[11] The U.T. Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu / Counseling Committee shall not be responsible, if the Selected / Nominated applicant is not admitted in the respective college due to Non-fulfillment of that College / State requirements for admission or any other reason. Thereafter the applicant will not be eligible for any other changes in Nomination / Selection of other seats.

[12] MODE OF SELECTION FOR DIPLOMA COURSES:

Selection/Nomination of applicants against central pool reserved seats for Diploma Courses for which the prescribed minimum qualification is SSCE, shall be made as per Rules and Regulation approved by the Administrator of DNH and Daman & Diu for Government Polytechnic, Daman for admission to the Diploma Courses from time to time.

[13] MODE, FEES&NOMINATION AFTER SELECTION BY COUNSELLING:

- (a) The Centre-in Charge of the reporting center of the Union territory of Daman & Diu will endorse the nomination/seat allocation letter as issued to the applicant in the online mode by CSAB NEUT constituted by MHRD, New Delhi.
- (b) The fees and business rules as decided by CSAB-NEUT will have to be followed by the applicants from time to time. The applicant should report at reporting center for endorsing the allocation letter for every round.

[14] MODE OF NOMINATION AFTER SPOT ROUND:-

- i. After obtaining Agreement and Surety Bonds from the selected applicants, the Principal, Government Polytechnic, Daman will issue a letter nominating the applicants against the Central Pool Reserved Seats.
- ii. The applicant who does not intend to avail the benefit of nomination shall inform the Principal, Government Polytechnic, Daman in writing to that effect within one day from the date of receipt of nomination letter.

[15] APPEAL:-

The appeal against the order in this regard shall lie with the Hon'ble Administrator, U.T. Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu, who will be the final authority to decide the legality of nomination, etc. The order of the Hon'ble Administrator will be final.

[16] SAVINGS:-

The Hon'ble Administrator, U.T. Administration of DNH and Daman & Diu reserve all rights to modify/amend these rules whenever found necessary.

2. On demand made by Govt. of India, within Six months of the date of passing the Degree/Diploma Course, the candidate shall serve for not less than Three years in any _____ Department of Union Territories of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli or the Central Government as may be directed by the Administration of Daman & Diu within Six months passing Degree/Diploma Course.
3. During the period of Service as an Officer under clause 2, the candidate shall faithfully, diligently and with skill and ability perform his/her duties and observe the Rules for the time being in force made by the Administration or the President as the case may be, for regulating conduct of Government Servant.
4. While in service under clause 2, the remuneration, pay and allowances and other conditions of service of the candidate shall be regulated by the Rules and Order of the Union Territory or the Central Government as the said case may be, for the time being in force for the post in which he/she is appointed.
5. If the candidate leaves the said College before passing the Final Examination without previous permission of the Government in writing for any reason whatsoever including illness or if he/she is discharged or dismissed for misconduct or refuse to serve in accordance with Clause 2 hereof or resign or is dismissed for misconduct from such service, before the completion of Three years of service, then in any such event he/she shall pay the President on demand and without a demur such sum not exceeding Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) in case of Engineering seat as the Administration under this clause as to this commission of a breach as also to the amount of compensation payable in respect thereof shall be final and binding on the candidate.

6. Any sum falling due from the candidate under this Agreement may be recovered from him/her as arrears of land revenue.
7. If any dispute shall arise between the parties hereto in respect of this Agreement or any of the provisions herein contained of anything arising hereto except in respect of matter on which the decision of the Administration under clause 5 is declared to be final and binding the same shall be referred for the arbitration to the Administrator, Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli, whose decision thereon shall be final and binding on the parties.
