It is bring to the notice of all that various scholarships applications for SC/ST/OBC/Disability/Minority/EBC are invited for Fresh and Renewal Scholarship through Principal/Head Masters of the Schools/Institution/ITI/TTI/Polytechnic/Colleges of Dadra Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu Under the scholarship Scheme of various Ministries through National Scholarship Portal 2.0 (NSP 2.0) (<http://scholarships.gov.in>). Students studying in schools/institutions/colleges with AISHE Code/UDISE code shall be eligible for the scholarship scheme, concern school HM/Principal shall ensure that eligible students apply for the scholarship on NSP portal and approve the same as per the eligibility criteria and forward to District/State authority for further process.

Important notice for Institutes

1. For accepting applications online from eligible students the institute/school/college must complete their registration form and get it verified from District/State Nodal Officer failing which the institute/school/college will not be able to verify the applications on-line.
2. Those institute/Schools with valid DISE/AISHE code can only register on NSP Portal.
3. Scheme guidelines and detailed eligibility criteria available on Portal for each scheme, Student as well as institutes are requested to kindly go through the guidelines thoroughly.
4. Renewal applications awards once made payable will be payable upto completion of course subject to performance and attendance as per the guidelines.
5. All INO/DNO/SNO need to complete their e-KYC in the portal irrespective of the schemes. Procedure for the same will be shared separately.

Important notice for Students

-Compulsory Documents for Students:

1. Aadhaar Number (UID), Student who do not have an Aadhaar number will be given an option to register through their EID numbers and will be given 30 day time to obtain the Aadhaar number. On receiving the Aadhaar number students are required to update that on the scholarship portal.

For Minor applicants (age lesser than 18 years) who do not have Aadhaar, it will be mandatory of parent or Legal guardian to provide their Aadhaar and for such cases minor would open a joint bank account with parent/legal guardian and it would be seeded with parent/legal guardian Aadhaar.


