NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 14 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (Central Act 30 of 2013), the U.T. Administration of DNH and DD hereby extend the time limit in publishing the Notification as per sub-section (1) of Section 11 of LARR Act, 2013, from the date of appraisal of the Social Impact Assessment report by the Expert Group;

No. 65-01-LAQ-2022-23/1504 dated 21st October, 2022 and published in the Official Gazette Series-II No. 06 dated 24th February, 2023 has been issued in accordance with the provisions as per section (1) of section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in land Acquisition, 3744.28 sq. mts. of land in Bhucharwada Village for Land Acquisition from Bhucharwada Fatak to Tad Check Post Strengthening and Widening of NH 251 from Km 11.000 to Km 22.770 at District Diu.

AND WHEREAS, as per section 14 of RFCTLARR Act, 2013 where a Preliminary Notification under sub-section (1) of section 11 is not issued within twelve months from the date of appraisal of the Social Impact Assessment report submitted by the Expert Group under section 7, then, such report shall be deemed to have lapsed and a fresh Social Impact Assessment shall be required to be undertaken prior to acquisition proceedings under section 11. The date of appraisal of the Social Impact Assessment report by the Expert Group under section 7 was submitted on 09.06.2023 and the Notification under sub-section (1) of section 11 needs to be issued on or before 09.06.2024.

AND WHEREAS, as per section 14 of RFCTLARR Act, 2013, Government have the power to extend the period of twelve months, if in its opinion circumstances exist justifying the same and hence requested to extend the limit in publishing the Notification as per sub-section (1) of Section 11 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 from the date of expiry.

NOW THEREFORE, sanction is accorded to extend the time limit for a further period beyond 12 months from the date of expiry i.e. 09.06.2024 in publishing the Notification under sub-section (1) of section 11 by invoking the provisions contained in section 14 of RFCTLARR Act, 2013 with regard to the acquisition of 3744.28 sq. mts. of land in Bhucharwada Village for Land Acquisition from Bucharwada Fatak to Tad Check Post Strengthening and Widening of NH 251 from Km 11.000 to Km 22.770 at District Diu.

Whereas, it appears to the appropriate Government that a total of **3744.28 Sq. Mtrs.** (standard measurement) the land is required in the **Diu City, Diu District** for a public purpose, namely, the **Acquisition Land from Bucharwada Fatak to Tad Check Post Strengthening and Widening of NH 251 from Km 11.000 to Km 22.770 at District Diu.** The details of the land/lands for the above said project in the Diu City of Diu District is enclosed herewith as **Annexure I.** The Social Impact Assessment (SIA) was carried out by the SR Asia, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh, an Agency appointed by the Additional District Magistrate, Diu vide Order No.65-01-LAQ-2022-23/4925 dated 19/12/2022 and a report submitted/ preliminary investigation was conducted by a team constituted by Collector as laid down under rule 4. The summary of the Social Impact Assessment Report/ preliminary investigation is as follows (copy attached):

The land proposed for the project of acquisition of land from Bucharwada Fatak to Tad Check Post for Strengthening and widening of NH-251 from km 11.000 to km 22.770 at District Diu is required for smooth movement of all types of vehicles, beautification of existing road, to provide and strengthen basic amenities like water pipeline, gas line, electric line, gutter line, side shoulders and storm drainage system.

The existing carpet area from Bucharwada Fatak to Tad Check Post only 15 mts. And which resulting in accident prone area in the vicinity and for the same, as per ROW norms Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, New Delhi Notification Vide No. S.O. 838(E) Dated 4th March, 2014 the Right of Way has been specified of 30.0 mts. from road starting from Bucharwada Fatak to Tad Check Post for which the land acquisition is proposed will include cross section 1.5m Median + 10.0m Carriageway (both side) + 1.5m Footpath cum Drainage(both side) +2.75m Utility (both side).

It will also facilitate development of the region as the major tourist spot in West Coast of India specially to attract tourists from India as well as Foreigners as Diu has beautiful Beaches, Forts and Churches made with Portuguese art and culture and which will boost Tourism Sector and due to this more livelihood options may be created and this will become more beneficial to manage traffic and boost economy and income sources of the U.T.

The Dy. Collector, Diu is appointed as Administrator for the purpose of Rehabilitation and Resettlement of the affected families vide Notification dated 04/05/2015 u/s 43 of the Act. Therefore,

it is notified that for the above-said project in Diu District, a piece of land measuring 3744.285q. Mtrs. of standard measurement, whose detail description is as following, is under acquisition:

Whereas, it appears to the appropriate Government that a total of 4330.90 Sq. Mtrs. (standard measurement) land is required in Khanvel Village of Dadra and Nagar Haveli for public purpose, namely, for the Development of Khanvel Junction, the details of the land/lands for the above said project in the Khanvel Village area of Dadra and Nagar Haveli District is mentioned below. The Social Impact Assessment (SIA) was carried out by the SR Asia, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh. an Agency appointed by the Hon'ble Collector, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Silvassa vide Notification No. LAQ/Development/Khanvel Junction/2023/123/LAO/2023 dated: 21/11/2023 and a report submitted by the SR Asia, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh. after preliminary investigation was conducted by a team constituted by Collector as laid down under rule 4. The summary of the Social Impact Assessment Report/ preliminary investigation is as follows (copy attached):

The UT Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu intends to acquire the following lands in consultation with the Panchayat of Khanvel village of Dadra and Nagar Haveli, in the affected area and carry out a Social Impact Assessment Study for public purpose. The study was undertaken as per the provisions of Section 4 of The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2023.

The broad objective of the assignment is to carry out Social impact Assessment Study and Preparation of SIA Report and Social impact Management Plan in accordance with relevant domestic laws. Broader social impacts for SIA were assessed through a primary census survey of all project affected people to capture impacts and losses and a sample socio-economic survey among different groups as well as other forms of assessment to capture non-resettlement related impacts as well.

The total land required is 4330.90 Sq. Mtrs. as per notification No. LAQ/ Development/ Khanvel Junction/2023/123/LAO/2023 dated 21/11/2023 under section 4 Rule 3. Ownership of the proposed land to be acquired involves both private and public. The ownership of land is through heredity in case of Private Land. Project Affected Family (PAF) uses the land for residential and commercial purposes.

After careful analysis of the data collected through a questionnaire, interview with the PAF, and meetings with officials, site visit and based on the issues raised during public hearing following recommendations are made.

- I. *District Administration shall acquire the land for the proposed development project and all the PAFs shall be compensated as per the LARR Act 2013.*
- II. *All the PAFs are willing to give their land for the proposed project if they are provided with fair and timely compensation, however mitigation measures need to be taken to reduce the impact of the proposed land acquisition.*
- III. *District administration may engage with the project affected families and may provide with adequate compensation as per the Land Acquisition Act 2013 for the successful completion of the proposed project.*
- IV. *Father of the Church named Victor D'Souza has raised concerns with regard to the trees planted in the ground. As there are around 70 Ashoka trees on the proposed land to be acquired. Hence District administration may engage with the project affected families and may come up with an amicable solution for the successful completion of the proposed project as per the Land Acquisition Act 2013.*
- V. *This project does not involve Rehabilitation and resettlement of PAFs. Therefore, there is no need to prepare R&R Action plans.*
- VI. *There is both private and Government land under acquisition. There is no opposition to this land acquisition proceeding. The proposed land can be acquired however compensation shall be made considering the market value of the land so that PAP/PAFS are minimally affected.*
- VII. *All the provisions of schedule 2 of the RFCTLARR-2013 should be considered. Case to case basis special assistance and support provisions may be considered for the PAPS Necessary arrangements may be made to reduce the impact during construction and development of Khanvel junction. Drinking water facility and Police booth need to be shifted before the construction to avoid the damage.*

A total of 26 families/households the estimate numbers of families being affected are about 11 private lands and 15 Government lands being likely to be affected.

The Resident Deputy Collector, Khanvel is appointed as Administrator for the purpose of Rehabilitation and Resettlement of the affected families vide Notification no. LAQ/RFCTLARRA, 2013-2015/174 dated 11/08/2015 u/s 44 (1) and Section 43(1) of the Act-2013. Therefore, it is notified that for the above-said project in Dadra & Nagar Haveli District, a piece of land Admeasuring **4330.90 sq. mtr.** of standard measurement, whose detail description is as following, is under acquisition:
