CIRCULAR

All registered waste tyre recyclers, importers, crumb rubber producers, Tyre Pyrolysis Oil (TPO) units, and other stakeholders under the jurisdiction of Pollution Control Committee DNH & DD are hereby informed that import of waste tyres is permitted only for environmentally sound recycling into end products such as reclaimed rubber, crumb rubber, crumb rubber modified bitumen (CRMB), and recovered carbon black. The import and use of waste tyres (directly or indirectly) for production of Tyre Pyrolysis Oil (TPO) or char is strictly prohibited, as per the provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 (as amended).

To prevent indirect routing of imported waste tyres to TPO units through processed forms (e.g., crumb rubber or tyre chips), the following directions are issued for immediate and strict compliance:

1. Prohibition on Sale/Supply by Crumb Rubber Producers:

Units producing crumb rubber from imported waste tyres shall not sell, supply, or transfer such crumb rubber (or any intermediate product derived from imported waste tyres) to any Tyre Pyrolysis Oil (TPO) units.

2. Record Maintenance and Traceability:

- Crumb rubber producers using imported waste tyres shall maintain separate batch-wise records of import, processing, production of crumb rubber, and sales (including buyer details, quantity, invoices, and end-use declaration from buyers).
- An undertaking/affidavit shall be submitted annually to PCC DNH&DD confirming that no crumb rubber produced from imported waste tyres has been supplied to TPO units.
- All transactions shall be reported quarterly on the CPCB's centralized EPR Waste Tyre Portal (eprtyres.cpcb.gov.in) and submitted to PCC DNH&DD.

3. Penalties for Non-Compliance:

Non-compliance will attract strict action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, and Hazardous and Other Wastes Rules, including:

- Imposition of Environmental Compensation.
- Revocation of Consent/Registration on EPR Portal.
- Closure directions and legal prosecution.

All concerned units are hereby directed to ensure immediate compliance with the above instructions. This circular shall come into force with immediate effect.
