About NHM

National Health Mission seeks to provide equitable, affordable, and quality health care which is accountable at the same time responding to the needs of the people. The thrust of the mission is on establishing a fully functional, community-owned, decentralized health delivery system with inter-sectoral convergence at all levels, to ensure simultaneous action on a wide range of determinants of health. The key features in order to achieve the goals of the Mission include making the public health delivery system fully functional and accountable to the community, human resources management, community involvement, decentralization, rigorous monitoring & evaluation against standards, the convergence of health and related programmes from village level upwards, innovations and flexible financing and also interventions for improving the health indicators.

Purpose of the Role:

The Public Health Expert will function as a senior-level strategic and technical advisor within the State NHM team, playing a pivotal role in shaping and driving the public health agenda of Uttarakhand. This position requires a visionary professional with deep understanding of health systems, who can effectively bridge the gap between policy and on-ground implementation. The expert will lead the formulation, execution, and monitoring of high-impact, evidence-informed public health strategies that address the unique geographic, demographic, and epidemiological context of the state.

Incumbent will be responsible for integrating vertical health programs (such as RMNCHA+, NCDs, communicable diseases, and urban health) into a cohesive, people-centered service delivery model under NHM. The role also demands the identification, incubation, and scaling of innovations in service delivery, digital health, and systems governance ensuring that reforms are sustainable, inclusive, and equitable. By fostering convergence across departments, leveraging partnerships with technical agencies and donors, and strengthening institutional capacities at all levels. The expert will play a critical role in transforming Uttarakhand's health system into a more responsive and resilient one.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Strategic Leadership & Health Systems Planning

- Lead the development of state-specific health strategies aligned with national goals (e.g., SDG 3, Ayushman Bharat, Universal Health Coverage) and programs.
- Support evidence-driven prioritization of public health interventions across domains (RMNCHA+, NCDs, Mental Health, Urban Health, etc.).
- Drive convergence between NHM, Medical Education, Health Insurance, and Digital Health initiatives at the state level.

- Guide cross-cutting reforms in HRH deployment, supply chain management, digital systems (e.g., ABDM), and service quality.
- Promote systems for continuum of care and referral linkages across primary, secondary, and tertiary facilities.
