ADVERTISEMENT FOR ENGAGEMENT OF PARA LEGAL VOLUNTEERS (PLVs)

The State Legal Services Authority, Daman & Diu, invites applications from eligible and socially committed persons for engagement as Para Legal Volunteers (PLVs) to assist the Legal Services Institutions in spreading legal awareness and facilitating access to justice for the weaker and marginalized sections of society.

The engagement shall be made in accordance with the NALSA Scheme for Para Legal Volunteers (Revised).

1. Nature of Work

Para Legal Volunteers will assist the Legal Services Institutions in the following activities:

- Creating legal awareness among citizens, particularly weaker sections of society.
- Assisting people in approaching Legal Services Authorities for free legal aid.
- Helping in organizing legal literacy camps and awareness programmes.
- Assisting in Lok Adalats, Legal Aid Clinics and Front Offices.
- Guiding victims of crime, women, children, labourers and other vulnerable groups regarding their legal rights.
- Reporting violations of law such as child labour, trafficking, domestic violence etc. to the Legal Services Authorities.
- Facilitating ADR mechanisms like Lok Adalat, mediation and conciliation for settlement of disputes.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants should preferably belong to any of the following categories:

- Teachers (including retired teachers)
- Retired Government servants / senior citizens
- Social Workers / MSW students
- Anganwadi workers
- Doctors / health workers
- Students (including law students)
- Members of NGOs and social service organizations
- Members of Self Help Groups / Women groups
- Any other socially committed person willing to serve the community

Educational Qualification

Minimum Qualification:

- 10th Pass (Matriculation) from a recognized Board.

Preferred Qualification:

- 12th Pass / Graduate in any discipline.
- Candidates having experience in social service, community work, legal awareness programmes, or welfare schemes will be given preference.

Other Requirements

- Resident of **Daman or Diu**
- Good moral character
- Interest in social service and legal awareness activities

3. Honorarium

Para Legal Volunteers are not salaried employees. They will be paid honorarium of ₹750/- per day for the days they are actually engaged in PLV work, as per the latest guidelines issued by the National Legal Services Authority.

4. Training

Selected candidates shall undergo orientation and training programmes conducted by the Legal Services Authority before being deployed as Para Legal Volunteers.

5. Selection Procedure

- Applications will be scrutinized by the by the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Daman.
- Shortlisted candidates will be called for interaction/interview.
- Preference shall be given to women and candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/minority communities.

6. Disqualifications

A person shall not be eligible if he/she:

- Is actively involved in political activities
- Has been accused or convicted of an offence
- Has misused public position or engaged in misconduct
- Is physically or mentally incapable of performing duties

7. How to Apply

Interested candidates may submit the prescribed application form along with the following documents:

- Proof of Age
- Educational Qualification Certificate
- Identity Proof
- Address Proof
- Two passport size photographs

Applications in the prescribed format along with self-attested copies of relevant documents must reach the following address: **The Ad-hoc Member Secretary, State Legal Services Authority, Room No. 4, District & Sessions Court, Fort Area, Moti Daman – 396220.**

The application should be submitted in a closed envelope clearly superscribed as: **“Application for Engagement as Para Legal Volunteer (PLV)”** on or before 20-04-2026.
