Notification

The Governor is pleased to allow to make the following rules or providing financial aid for fulfilling the purposes of encouragement for modernization of Madrasas and computer education-

The Uttarakhand Madarsa Education Modernization Aid Rules, 2019

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| Short title
and
commencement | 1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttarakhand Madrasa Education Modernization Aid Rules, 2019.
(2) It shall extend to the whole state of Uttarakhand.
(3) They shall come into force at once. |
| Execution | 2. For the aid of the modernization of Madrasas/ computer education in the State, the following proceeding shall be executed—
(a) At district level the concerned District Minority Welfare Officer/ District Social Welfare Officer shall prepare and forward the proposals to Directorate of Minority Welfare. The District Minority Welfare Officer/ District Social Welfare Officer, as applicable, while preparing the proposal shall also get suggestions from the District Level 15 Point Program Committee, as required;
(b) Directorate of Minority Welfare, shall collectively forward the proposals prepared by itself and the relevant proposals received at district level to the Government;
(c) A Management Committee shall be constituted under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary/ Secretary Minority Welfare Department, Uttarakhand Government for approving and effective implementation/ evaluation and monitoring of the proposals. Financial approval shall be |

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provided in the order of the recommendations of the committee. The structure of the above committee shall be as follows—

- (1) Principal Secretary/ Secretary Minorities Welfare Department of Government Uttarakhand - Chairman
 - (2) Director, Minorities Welfare of Government Uttarakhand - Vice Chairman
 - (3) Additional Secretary, Finance Department, Government of Uttarakhand - Member
 - (4) Additional Secretary/ Joint Secretary/ Deputy Secretary/ Under Secretary, Minorities Welfare Department Government of Uttarakhand - Member
 - (5) Director General, Education or an officer nominated by him, whose rank shall not be below then Additional Director - Member
 - (6) Finance Officer, Directorate of Minority Welfare - Member
 - (7) Deputy Director, Directorate of Minority Welfare Dehradun - Convener Member
- (d) Funds may be demanded for infrastructure development, furniture, computer, library, electric appliances, clean drinking water, toilet, generator etc in Madrasa;
- (e) Under the above scheme, the aid shall be provided for the construction of classes rooms infrastructure development etc in Madarasas, such Madrasa shall be given priority which are not covered under the guidelines of the "Infrastructure Development in Minority Institutions Scheme" Government of India, but in reality, it is necessary to develop infrastructure in the Madarasas;
- (f) In the Madrasas of the State, for construction of infrastructure and construction of toilets maximum upto 30 lakh rupees shall be provided, in which 75 percent of total amount shall be borne by the State Government and remaining 25 percent amount shall be borne by the Madrasa itself;
- (g) Maximum 5 lakh rupees shall be provided for establishment of computer education/ modern library in the Madrasas.


Quorum

3. The minimum quorum for the meeting of the Management Committee formed under the above rule 2(c) shall be one more than the half.

Meetings of Management Committee

4. The meeting of the committee shall be organized quarterly, for which 15 days prior notice shall be given. The meetings may be convened by the Chairman at any time in special circumstances, but in the case of special/ indispensable circumstances, the proposal shall be accepted by the Chairman and the post facto approval shall be made at the next meeting of the committee. In order to fulfill the objectives of the scheme, the committee shall approve by examining proposals received in each financial year considering the limit of budget set for the operation of the scheme. The remaining proposals which are not considered by committee or rejected by the committee shall be lapsed at the end of the financial year.

Norms for grant to Madrasas


5. Under this scheme, the grant shall be given to such Madrasas which fulfills the following norms—
- (i) Under the scheme, only such Madrasas shall be considered for grant which provides Deeni Talim as well as modern education like Maths, Science, English, Computer education etc to the studying students in the Madrasa;
 - (ii) Only those Madrasas shall be taken under the scheme, which are recognized by the Uttarakhand Madrasa Education Board;
 - (iii) For grant, the related Madrasa shall be recognized atleast 3 years prior ;
 - (iv) Tuition fee of more than Rs. 500 has not been collected by the Madarsa students;
 - (v) If an institution has been recognized by both Madrasa and school, in such situation, only such institution shall be able to get the benefit under this scheme, where Madrasa and school are operated separately and modern and Deeni Talim teachers are deployed as per rules, the amount provided under this scheme shall be spent only for the Madrasa;
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- (vi) While forwarding the proposal from the district level, it shall also be taken into account that whether all the students of the Madrasas fill the form of the scholarship schemes provided by the Government of India or State Government, Besides it, other departmental works such as Aadhar registration of all persons related to students/ teachers/management to provide information to the department from time to time, co-operative behavior of madarsa in respect of implementation of Sarv Sikhsa Abhiyan properly etc.
- (vii) No financial/administrative irregularity has ever been done by the Madrasa.
- (viii) If any Madrasa has received funds under the Minority Development Fund Scheme, then in such a situation, the concerned Madrasa shall be considered for sanctioning fund only after 5 financial years under this scheme.
- (ix) Once a Madrasa has received the funds under this scheme, then the committee shall consider on the proposal of the concerned Madrasas only after 5 financial years as per rules.
- (x) The proposals received from the districts shall be intensively examined at the Directorate of Minority Welfare level and thereafter only the relevant proposals shall be forwarded to the Government, on which the committee shall consider the matter on the basis of merits and shall reasonably decide the same.
- (xi) As the result of declaration of rules laid down for the modernization of Madrasas/ computer education, the Madrasa benefited in this scheme shall not be covered in future under Minority Development Fund Management, 2012 published by the office Memorandum No. 125/xvii-3/13-07(ii)/2012 dated 26-02-2013 shall deemed amended to the said extent.
- (xii) The benefited Madrasa, under the said scheme shall made available the utilization certificate of funds along with photographs to the Director, Minority welfare fund.

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| Records | 6. | The necessary records of the committee shall be prepared and kept by the convening member, i.e. Deputy Director, Directorate of Minority Welfare. |
| Monitoring | 7. | The amount of aid given shall be reviewed time to time, as per rules. |
| Miscellaneous | 8. | In the case of ambiguity at any point, the decision of Government shall be valid. |
