A Brief Report of Sugamya Yatra 2025.

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation, and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (CRCSRE) – Guwahati (under the administrative control of SVNIRTAR, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India) conducted SUGAMYA YATRA on January 07,2025 in collaboration with State Commissioner of Persons with Disability, Assam and NGOs in Guwahati .

The primary objective of Sugamya Yatra 2025 was to raise mass awareness about accessibility challenges faced by Persons with Disabilities and to sensitize stakeholders about their responsibilities under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016.

The Yatra focused on sensitising the public and authorities about accessibility rights and obligations, visiting key public places, including government offices, educational institutions, healthcare centers, religion places and tourist spots to assess accessibility, promoting a constructive and collaborative approach towards improving accessibility.

Activities conducted: The event was conducted in a peaceful and inclusive manner, ensuring constructive engagement with local authorities and stakeholders. The participants were encouraged to provide feedback to concerned officials to foster improvements in accessibility across public infrastructure. During the Yatra, a special public awareness was created regarding accessibility challenges faced by persons with disabilities (Divyangjans).

The program primarily focused sensitizing stakeholders about their responsibilities under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016, and the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD). In an effort to emphasize the importance of accessibility in education, the officials along with special children visited shopping mall (Mega Plaza- Beltola), Srimanta Sankaradev Kalakshetra а cultural institution at Panjabari Guwahati, Assam and state Library, Guwahati to discuss accessibility-related concerns.
