Overview

The Cross Disability Early Intervention Centre (CDEIC), Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation, and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (CRCSRE) – Guwahati successfully organized an Awareness Program for children with autism and other related issues on 16th July 2025 at group centre, CRPF, Guwahati under the leadership and guidance of Dr. P. K. Lenka, Director, CRCSRE Guwahati.

The guest of the programme was NeelamDhyani, Head RCWA. The aim of the programme was to create awareness regarding autism and other related issues of CWSN. The total number of participants were 100 including the parents of CWSN and other staff members.

In the beginning, a brief introduction about CRC and CDEIC were discussed. After the introduction, definition of autism, its various causes and various treatment processes were discussed with the participants. Along with this, importance of early identification, screening and intervention of various disabilities were discussed with the participants. Different causes of delayed milestones of a child was discussed with examples. Benefits of UDID was discussed as most of the participants were not aware of it. Some participants also shared their experiences regarding their children facing difficulties and various treatment processes and references were provided to them for better treatment.

Key outcomes and focus areas-

1. The awareness programme has spread awareness regarding autism and other related issues of CWSN.
2. Provided awareness regarding various treatment processes in the field of disability.
3. Create awareness on UDID and its benefits.
