- 2. Interdisciplinary Collaboration: The CRE will foster stronger interdisciplinary coordination among physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, and caregivers for holistic management of Down's Syndrome.
- 3. Capacity Building: The program will enhance the skills of teachers and rehabilitation professionals for better service delivery.
- 4. Educational Management: The CRE will foster implementation of effective teaching-learning methods and inclusive education practices for children with Down Syndrome.
- 5. Community and Family Engagement: Emphasis will be placed on strategies for family education, psychosocial support, and community-based rehabilitation to ensure sustainable care beyond clinical settings.
