## Report on One-Day Local Level CRE Programme

### Introduction

A one-day Local Level Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) programme on the theme "Fostering Inclusive Classrooms: Principles, Practices, and Management" was successfully organized by CRC-SRE, Guwahati on 23rd October 2025 at its auditorium. The programme was accredited by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), New Delhi, under reference number F.No.7-16(129)/2025-RCI.

A total of 38 participants, comprising special educators and therapists from various institutions, actively took part in the programme. The primary objective was to enhance participants' understanding and competencies in promoting inclusive practices within educational settings, aligned with the vision of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016 and the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

### **Programme Overview**

The CRE comprised six interactive sessions, facilitated by eminent professionals and experienced resource persons from the field of special education and rehabilitation. The sessions were designed to provide both theoretical grounding and practical approaches for inclusive classroom implementation.

# **Session Highlights**

**Session I:** Introduction to Inclusive Education

Resource Person: Shri Lanu Areng Aimol.

The inaugural session introduced the concept of inclusive education, covering its definition, key principles, and global as well as national perspectives. Emphasis was placed on legal and policy frameworks, including the RPwD Act, 2016, NEP 2020, and UNCRPD. Participants explored the distinctions between inclusive and integrated education. A group activity encouraged participants identify existing barriers in their classrooms, fostering critical reflection on challenges faced in inclusive settings.



**Session II:** Understanding Learner Diversity

Resource Person: Shri Duplay Kr. Das

This session provided an in-depth understanding of learner diversity, addressing differences in disability types, languages, socio-economic backgrounds, and cultural contexts. The discussion centered on identifying and catering to Special Educational Needs (SEN). Through case studies on children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), ADHD,



Learning Disabilities (LD), and Hearing Impairment, participants gained practical insights into recognizing and responding to diverse learner profiles.

**Session III:** Inclusive Teaching Strategies **Resource Person**: Shri Rajesh Kumar

The third session focused on effective pedagogical strategies to ensure inclusion. Concepts such as Universal Design for Learning (UDL), Differentiated Instruction, Peer Tutoring, and Cooperative Learning were thoroughly discussed. Participants explored how these frameworks can help teachers design flexible curricula to accommodate varying learner needs and strengths.



**Session IV:** Classroom Management for Inclusion

**Resource Person:** Ms. Barsha Devi Bordoloi

This session highlighted importance of creating safe, supportive, and learner-friendly classroom **Participants** learned environments. support, about positive behavior managing group dynamics, and establishing inclusive routines and norms. An engaging activity on classroom



layout design enabled participants to visualize physical arrangements that promote accessibility and participation for all learners.

**Session V:** Role of Stakeholders and Support Systems

**Resource Person**: Shri Lanu Areng Aimol

This session underscored the collaborative of inclusive nature roles of parents, education. The communities. special educators. therapists, and school management teams were discussed in detail. Participants explored mechanisms for interdisciplinary collaboration. Individualized Education Plans (IEPs),



and resource room utilization. The discussion reinforced that inclusion thrives on teamwork, empathy, and shared responsibility.

**Session VI:** Action Planning and Wrap-Up Resource Person: Dr. Dipak Kumar

The final session was dedicated to action planning and reflective practice. Participants engaged in group work to draft Inclusive Action Plans for their institutions. They respective later presented their plans, followed by an open Q&A session and feedback sharing. The reflections revealed a strong commitment among educators to



translate inclusive principles into practice and to advocate for systemic change within their schools.

### Conclusion

The one-day CRE programme concluded successfully with positive feedback from participants, who expressed that the sessions were highly informative, interactive, and applicable to real classroom situations. The resource persons were lauded for their expertise and practical approach.

The programme not only enhanced professional competencies but also fostered a collective vision toward inclusive, equitable, and quality education for all learners. The event reaffirmed CRC-SRE Guwahati's commitment to continuous professional development and to building an inclusive educational ecosystem in the region.
