3.	Combined School Grant (Pri.)	Combined School Grant is sanctioned in principle to local self-government primary schools with the highest class being Class 8 on the basis of school enrollment criteria. 4.	Combined School Grant (Sec.)	Combined School Grant has been sanctioned in principle to a total of 7 secondary schools having the highest class up to 10th or 12th class as per the criteria of school enrollment. The grant is approved for Ashram Schools run by the Government Tribal Development Department, schools run by the Social Welfare Department, Vidyyaniketan as well as local body self government schools (Zilla Parishad, Municipality) joint school grant for government secondary schools.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
