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CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

No. BME. 3583/599/(CR-487)/87/ADE-5.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating requirement to the *Gazetee* posts in the Dairy Engineering Group in the Dairy Development Department of the Government of Maharashtra indicated in Schedule-I.

1. These rules may be called the *Gazetted* posts in the Dairy Engineering Group (under the Dairy Development Department of Government of Maharashtra) (Recruitment) Rules, 1989.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department" means the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department of Government;

(b) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;

(c) "degree" means a degree of a statutory University;

(d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(e) "Schedule" means Schedule appended to these rules.

3. Appointment to the post of *Senior Dairy Engineer* in the Dairy Engineering Group as mentioned in the Schedule I, in General State Service, Class-I (Supertime Scale) shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the posts of Dairy Engineer in the Dairy Engineering Group, in General State Service, Class-I (Senior), as mentioned in Schedule I, having Engineering qualifications; or

(b) by transfer of a suitable person from any equivalent cadre in any Government Department possessing qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination mentioned in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c);

(c) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 45 years of age;

(ii) possess second class degree in the Dairy Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Refrigeration Engineering, or any other qualification as may be recognised by the Government as equivalent thereto; and

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(iii) possess a total experience of seven years out of which at least five years should, in the opinion of the Commission, be in a responsible senior executive capacity, in a large size dairy or milk packaging plant or milk products making plant, gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii);

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates having post-graduate degree or diploma or a first class degree in the subject mentioned in sub-clause (ii).

4. Appointment to the post of Dairy Engineer in the Dairy Engineering Group, in General State Service, Class-I (Senior), as mentioned in Schedule I, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Deputy Dairy Engineer in the Dairy Engineering Group, in General State Service, Class-I (Junior), as mentioned in Schedule I, having Engineering qualifications; or

(b) by transfer of a suitable person from any equivalent cadre in any Government Department possessing qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination mentioned in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c);

(c) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age;

(ii) possess second class degree, in the Dairy Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Refrigeration Engineering, or any other qualification as may be recognised by the Government as equivalent thereto;

(iii) possess total experience of five years of which atleast three years should be, in the opinion of the Commission, in a responsible capacity in a large size dairy or milk packaging plants or milk product making plant, gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii);

Provided that, preference may be given to the candidates having post-graduate degree or diploma or a First Class degree in any of Engineering subjects mentioned in sub-clause (ii).

5. Appointment to the post of Deputy Dairy Engineer in the Dairy Engineering Group in General State Service Class-I (Junior) as mentioned in Schedule-I, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Assistant Dairy Engineers or Training Superintendent (Dairy Engineering) in the Dairy Engineering Group in General State Services, Class-II, having Engineering qualifications and also having experience of not less than 3 years in Class-II cadre in Dairy Engineering Group as mentioned in Schedule I; or

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(b) by transfer of a suitable person from any equivalent cadre in any Government Department possessing qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination mentioned in clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c); or

(c) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 35 years of age;

(ii) possess a second class degree in the Dairy Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Refrigeration Engineering or any other qualification as may be recognised by the Government as equivalent thereto for the said post; and

(iii) possess in the opinion of the Commission, 3 year's experience in a large Dairy or Milk packaging plants or milk-products making plants :

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates having post-graduate degree or diploma or a first class degree in any of the subjects mentioned in sub-clause (ii) above.

6. Appointment to the posts of Assistant Dairy Engineer or Training Superintendent (Dairy Engineering) or such other equivalent post as may be included in the Dairy Engineering Group in General State Service, Class-II mentioned in Schedule-I, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts mentioned in Schedule-II appended hereto and possessing experience of not less than 3 year's in the Class-III cadres mentioned in the said Schedule-II in the Dairy Engineering Group; or

(b) by transfer of a suitable person from any equivalent cadre in any Department of Government possessing qualification prescribed for appointment by nomination mentioned in clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c); or

(c) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in service of Government, are not more than 30 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in second class in Dairy Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Refrigeration Engineering or any other equivalent qualification recognised by the Government, for the said post.

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates having post-graduate degree or diploma or a first class degree in any of the subjects mentioned in clause (ii) of this rule.

7. The age limit mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 of these rules may be relaxed by Government on the recommendations of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

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8. If candidates with the prescribed period of experience are not available in sufficient number, those with experience of a shorter period may also be considered by the Commission.

9. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c) of rule 5, and sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) of rule 6 of these rules, if at any stage of selection the Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite higher basic academic qualification or experience or both are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to Schedule Castes, Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes then the Commission, may, in the matter of such selection to the posts to which rules 5 and 6 apply, relax the requirement in respect of the class of degree or the period of experience or both, set out therein, and select suitable candidates belonging to such castes or tribes.

10. Appointment to the posts mentioned in rules 5 and 6 of these rules shall be made by promotion and nomination in the ratio of 50 : 50.

Provided that, if in the opinion of Government, the exigencies of service so require, the Government may after consultation with the Commission, whenever necessary, make appointment to the posts mentioned in rules 5 and 6 of these rules in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules.

11. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 of these rules by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years and will have to undergo an in-service training during probation unless the incumbent is already working in the Dairy Development Department of Government.

12. A person appointed to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4, 5 and 6 of these rules whether by promotion or transfer or nomination, shall be required to pass the Departmental Examinations and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing these examinations.

13. A person appointed to the posts shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the state of Maharashtra.

14. The selected candidate shall if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service or post connected with the Defence of India, anywhere in India or abroad, for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any, on such conditions as are determined by the Government of India :

Provided that, such person,—

(a) shall not be required to serve as mentioned in this rule, after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment; and

(b) shall not ordinarily be required to serve as mentioned in this rule after attaining the age of 40 years.
