STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Committee on National Integration and Regionalism appointed the National Integration Council recommended that article 19 of the Constitution be amended that adequate powers become available SO for the preservation and maintenance of the integrity, and sovereignty of the Union. THE CONSTITUTION (SIXTEENTH AMENDMENT) ACT, 1963

[5th October, 1963.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fourteenth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title.-This Act may be called the Constitution (Sixteenth Amendment) Act, 1963.
- 2. Amendment of article 19.-In article 19 of the Constitution,-
- (a) in clause (2), after the words "in the interests of", the words "the sovereignty and integrity of India," shall be inserted;
- (b) in clauses (3) and (4), after the words "in the interests of", the words "the sovereignty and integrity of India or" shall be inserted.
- 3. Amendment of article 84.-In article 84 of the Constitution, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-
- is citizen of India. and makes and subscribes before some person authorized in that behalf by the Election Commission an oath affirmation according to the form set out for the purpose in Third the Schedule:".
- 4. Amendment of article 173.-In article 173 of the Constitution, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-
- and a citizen of India, and makes subscribes before some person authorized in that behalf by the Election Commission an oath or affirmation according to the form set out for the purpose the Third Schedule;".
- 5. Amendment of Third Schedule.- In the Third Schedule to the Constitution,-
- In Form I. after the words "Constitution of (a) law established.". the "that I words will uphold the sovereignty and integrity of India," shall be inserted;
- (b) for Form III, the following shall be substituted, namely:---

Form of oath or affirmation to be made by a candidate for election to Parliament:--
