[30th March, 1988.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Thirty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. Short title.-This Act may be called the Constitution (Fifty-ninth Amendment) Act, 1988.

2. Amendment of article 356.-In article 356 of the Constitution, in clause (5).for the proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

clause "Provided that nothing this Proclamation in shall apply to the issued under clause 11th day of (1) on the May, 1987 with respect to the State of Puniab.".

3. Insertion of new article 359A.-(1) After article 359 of the Constitution, the following article shall be inserted, namely:-

`359A. Application Part Punjab.of this to the State of Notwithstanding anything in this Constitution. this Part shall, in the relation to State of Punjab, be subject to the following modifications, namely:-

(a) in article 352,-

(i) in clause (1),-

(A) for the opening portion, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"If the President is satisfied that a grave emergency exists whereby-

security of India or of any part of the (a) the territory thereof is threatened, whether by aggression war or external or armed rebellion; or

(b) the integrity of India is threatened by internal disturbance in the whole or any part of the territory of Punjab,

he may, by Proclamation, make a declaration to that effect in respect of the whole of Punjab or of such part of the territory thereof as may be specified in the Proclamation.";

(B) in the Explanation,-

(1)after the words "armed rebellion". the words or that the internal the integrity of India is threatened bv disturbance whole in or any part of the territory of Punjab," shall be inserted;

(2) after the words "or rebellion", the words "or disturbance" shall be inserted;

(ii) (9), "armed rebellion". in clause after the words at both the places where they occur, the words "or internal disturbance" shall be inserted:

(b) in article 358. in clause (1), after the words by external "or aggression", the "or armed rebellion. words by or that the integrity is internal of India threatened by disturbance in the whole or any part of the territory of Punjab," shall be inserted;

(c) in article 359, for the words and figures "articles 20 and 21". at both the places where they occur, the word and figures "article 20" shall be substituted.'.

(2)The amendment made to the Constitution sub-section (1) shall by period of from cease to operate on the expiry of a two years the commencement of this Act, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such cesser.
