STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

THE CONSTITUTION (TWENTY-SECOND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1969

[25th September, 1969.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Twentieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title.- This Act may be called the Constitution (Twenty-second Amendment) Act, 1969.
- 2. Insertion of new article 244A.-In Part X of the Constitution, after article 244, the following article shall be inserted, namely:-

244A.-Formation of an autonomous State comprising certain tribal areas in Assam and creation of local Legislature or Council of Ministers or both therefor.-(1) Notwithstanding anything in this Constitution, Parliament may, by law, form within the State of Assam an autonomous State comprising (whether wholly or in part) all or any of the tribal areas specified in Part A of the table appended to paragraph 20 of the Sixth Schedule and create therefor-

- (a) a body, whether elected or partly nominated and partly elected, to function as a Legislature for the autonomous State, or
- (b) a Council of Ministers,
- or both with such constitution, powers and functions, in each case, as may be specified in the law.
- (2) Any such law as is referred to in clause (1) may, in particular,-
- specify the matters enumerated in State List or the Concurrent List with Legislature of the respect which the autonomous to State shall have power to make laws for the whole or any part thereof, whether to the exclusion of the Legislature of the State of Assam otherwise;
- (b) define the matters with respect to which the executive power of the autonomous State shall extend;
- (c) provide that any tax levied by the State of Assam shall be assigned to the autonomous State in so far as the proceeds thereof are attributable to the autonomous State:
- provide that article any reference to State in any of this Constitution shall be construed including a reference the as to autonomous State; and
- (e) make such supplemental, incidental and consequential provisions as may be deemed necessary.
- (3) An amendment of any such law as aforesaid in SO far such as amendment relates to any of the matters specified in sub-clause clause (2) effect sub-clause (b) of shall have no unless the amendment passed in each House of Parliament by not less than two-thirds the members present and voting.
- (4) Any such law as is referred to in this article shall not be deemed to be an amendment of this Constitution for the purposes of article 368 notwithstanding that it contains any provision which amends has the effect of amending this Constitution.".
- 3. Amendment of article 275.-In article 275 of the Constitution, after clause (1), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-
- "(1A) On and from the formation of the autonomous State under article 244A-

- 4. Insertion of new article 371B.-After article 371A of the Constitution, the following article shall be inserted, namely:-
- Special provision with respect the State of Assam.-Notwithstanding anything in this Constitution, President the may, by order made with respect to the State of Assam, provide the constitution and functions of a committee of the Legislative Assembly of the of members State consisting of that Assembly elected from areas specified in Part A of the table appended to paragraph 20 of the Sixth Schedule and such number other members of of that Assembly as may be specified in the order and for the modifications to made in the rules of of procedure that Assembly the constitution and proper functioning of such committee.".
