THE CONSTITUTION (FIFTY-EIGHTH AMENDMENT)

ACT, 1987

[9th December, 1987.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Thirty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title.-This Act may be called the Constitution (Fifty-eighth Amendment) Act, 1987.
- 2. Part XXII.-In Part XXII Amendment of the heading of the heading, word, "COMMENCEMENT", Constitution, in the after the the words ", AUTHORITATIVE TEXT IN HINDI" shall be inserted.
- 3. Insertion of new article 394A.-After article 394 of the Constitution, the following article shall be inserted, namely:-
- "394A. Authoritative text in the Hindi language.- (1) The President shall cause to be published under his authority,-
- translation of this Constitution in the Hindi language, by the members of the Constituent Assembly, with such modifications necessary to bring it in conformity with the be language, style and adopted in the authoritative texts of Central terminology the Hindi language, and incorporating therein all the amendments of this Constitution made before such publication; and
- (b) the translation in the Hindi language of every amendment of this Constitution made in the English language.
