The Hon'ble President visited the handloom and spinning units and theme pavilion at Pochampally in Yadadri Bhuvnagiri Distirct. The Hon'ble President unveiled tourist attractions at the Rastrapati Nilayam and inaugurated a 120-foot replica of a historic flagpost at the Rashtrapati Nilayam in Hyderabad. The replica is a reminder of the teak wood flagpost where the tricolour was hoisted for the first time in 1948 when the Hyderabad state integrated into the Indian Union.
