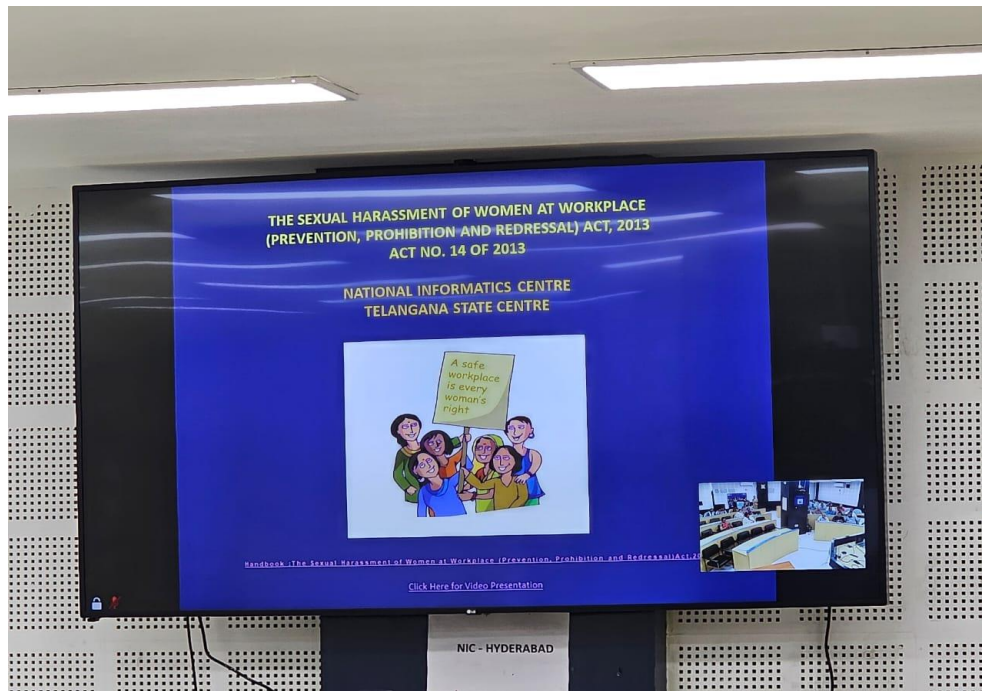

The leaders' involvement emphasizes the importance of the issue and reflects NIC Hyderabad's commitment to fostering a culture of awareness and prevention.

The program commenced with insightful speeches by the SIO and Head NIU setting the tone for the day. To further reinforce the importance of the subject, a

compelling short video was presented, providing a visual perspective on preventing sexual harassment at the workplace.



Creating Awareness Through Visuals

One of the highlights of the event was the incorporation of an online quiz, designed to actively engage participants and assess their understanding of the sensitization program. With over 250 participants including both NIC employees and outsourced staff, the quiz proved to be an effective tool in reinforcing key concepts. The scores were tabulated online, and individual answer sheets were generated, offering participants personalized feedback on their comprehension of the subject matter.
