



## NIC TELANGANA Polling Personnel Management System and Postal Ballot Management System

The NIC Telangana State Unit developed Polling Personnel Management System (PPMS) software, which was utilized for the Telangana State Legislative Assembly (TSLA) Elections 2023. Under the visionary guidance of Sh Ajay Madhukar Joshi, DDG & SIO NIC Telangana State, the PPMS application has been re-designed into a web-enabled platform and is currently being implemented for the House of Parliament (HoP)-2024 elections across all 33 districts of Telangana and Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, Hyderabad (GHMC).

The Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of Telangana requested NIC officials to operationalize the software by incorporating suggested modifications, feature enhancements, and additional functionality by the first week of February 2023. Additionally, the CEO requested the development of a new Postal Ballot Management System (PBMS). The election team discussed the new features and MIS reports in the PPMS and PBMS with Sri Vikas Raj, IAS, Chief Electoral Officer (CEO); Sri Lokesh Kumar DS, IAS, Additional CEO; and Sri Sarfaraz Ahmad, IAS, Joint CEO of Telangana State on January 30th, 2024. The application was developed and hosted at the NIC data centre, and the URL for PPMS is <https://eppms.nic.in>.



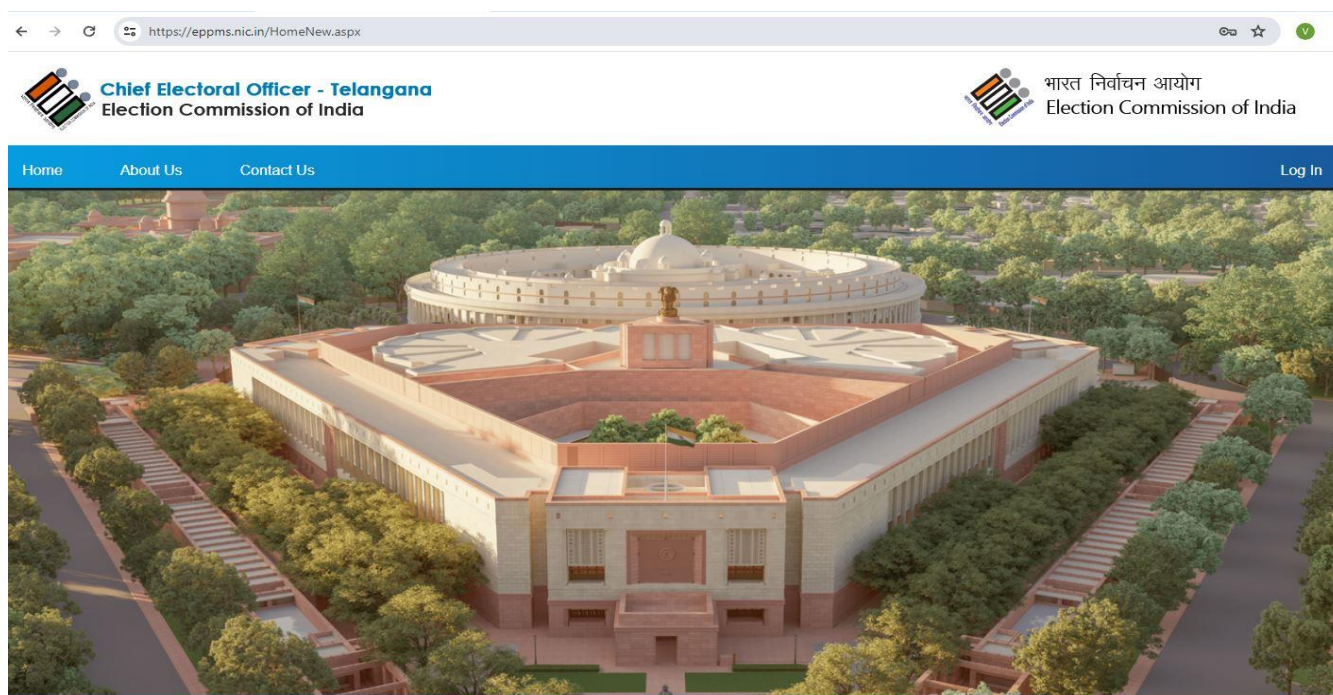
Discussion on online PPMS and PBMS by NIC election team with CEO, Additional CEO and Joint CEO of Telangana.

Sh Ajay Madhukar Joshi, DDG & SIO NIC Telangana State formed a dedicated development team for the PPMS and PBMS application software and to provide day-to-day support to the 33 districts of Telangana for implementation. The technical team assisted the district centres through video conference sessions, phone calls, messaging applications, and emails. Both these applications went live in March 2024.

The first and second randomizations of polling personnel were completed in all 33 districts using the online Polling Personnel Management System (PPMS) application. NIC Telangana State unit officers were deputed to 23 districts where there were no District Informatics Officer (DIO) present. All the deputed officers coordinated the second randomization of polling personnel on April 26<sup>th</sup> at various districts. The randomization process was conducted in the presence of General Observers, District Election Officers, Returning Officers, and all concerned nodal officers.

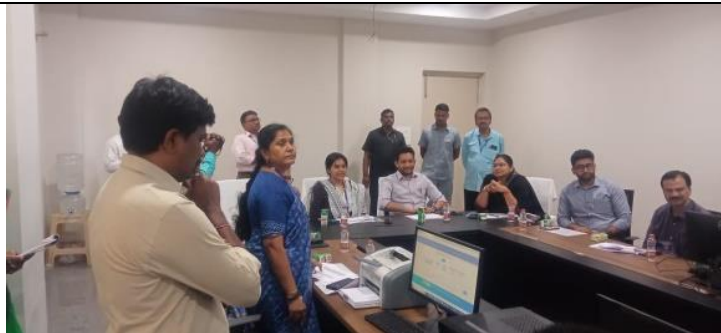

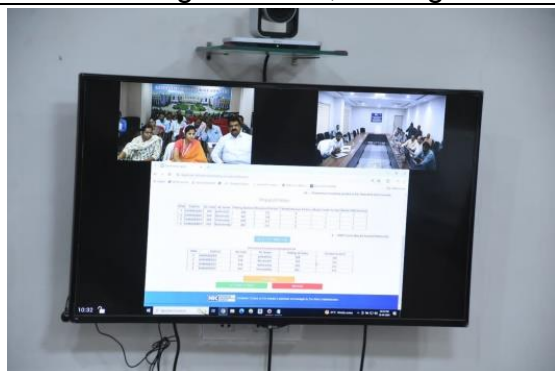
