1. High Court Website: The all-new official website for the High Court of Telangana has been developed for the benefit of advocates, litigants and other stakeholders of Judiciary. This new dynamic website has been developed using open-source tools such as PostgreSQL and spring boot framework.

The website focuses on providing visitors to the High Court website with an experience that is user-friendly, easy to navigate, clean, accessible and easy on the eyes. The site has undergone a security audit to make it safer and more secure to browse. The new Website is integrated with a content management system that allows the authorised users to upload documents such as circulars, notifications etc. The links to important portals such as case status information, display board, cause list, judgments, etc. are provided on the homepage itself, making them easily accessible.

The website has all the important links, like Judicial Information, Profiles of the Honourable Judges, Live Streaming Board, R.T.I. portal, e-services, recruitment, district judiciary, latest notifications and latest and important judgments of the High Court etc.

2. eTHCR (e Telangana High Court Reports) portal:

e.T.H.C.R. portal, which stands for e Telangana High Court Reports, which is a one stop solution to find all the judgments of the High Court. Using this web portal, the stakeholders can search judgments using case number, bench, party names, advocate names, order date, free text, subject and act. The Telugu translated versions of the reportable and important judgments of the Honourable Supreme Court of India and this High Court have been made available on this portal.

3. DigiTHCR (Digital Telangana High Court Reports) portal:

The Honourable Supreme Court of India, as part of the "Access to Justice for All" initiative, has directed all the High Courts to publish Digital Law Reports. The High Court has established an I.L.R wing for this purpose. This web portal hosts the reportable judgments of this High Court along with their Telugu translated versions on the official website of this High Court. This web portal allows advocates, law students, litigants and the general public to search for reported judgments by using T.H.C.R. number, name of party, year or volume, case number, neutral citation, order date and text. The reports are available free of cost to all interested stakeholders.
