



Report on the e-Cabinet project initiative to revolutionize governance in Telangana State.

Sri M. Raghunandan Rao, I.A.S, Secretary of GAD, Government of Telangana, has initiated implementation of the e-Cabinet project developed by NIC, Uttarakhand, for the Telangana Government.

In this regard, the Managing Director of TGTS had requested NIC to demonstrate the e-Cabinet project via videoconference initially; accordingly, a VC session has been organized by Sri Arun Sharma, Director (IT) at NIC, Uttarakhand, on February 14^{th,} 2025, at 3:15 PM regarding the project. Following the VC session, it was decided to invite Sri Arun Sharma, Director (IT), to Hyderabad to deliver a detailed project presentation in person.

Sri Arun Sharma, Director (IT), NIC, Uttarakhand, visited Hyderabad from February 27^{th,} 2025, to March 1^{st,} 2025, and demonstrated the e-Cabinet project. Later, all participants were addressed by the Honorable Smt. A. Shanti Kumari, IAS & Chief Secretary of the Government of Telangana, at 5:00 PM in the CS conference hall.
