

NIC Telangana: Rythu Bharosa – Agriculture Investment Support Scheme – 2025 Empowering Farmers, Strengthening Agriculture

The Rythu Bharosa scheme (formerly known as Rythu Bandhu), a flagship initiative of the Agriculture Department, Government of Telangana, continues to play a pivotal role in extending timely financial support to farmers through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT). Implemented under the technical assistance of the **NIC Agriculture Informatics Division – Telangana State Unit**, the scheme is designed to empower farmers by providing advanced assistance ahead of each crop season, enabling them to procure essential agricultural inputs such as seeds, fertilizers, and labour.

Since 2017, the NIC Agriculture Informatics Division has developed and maintaining a comprehensive, workflow-driven web application—<https://rythubharosa.telangana.gov.in>—to ensure seamless implementation of the Rythu Bharosa scheme under the guidance of the Agriculture Department. The platform efficiently captures detailed information of individual pattadars, including landholding, bank account, and mobile number, thereby facilitating accurate and timely disbursement of financial assistance.

On 16th June 2025, the Agriculture Department of Telangana held a special farmer outreach program, “Rythu Nestham,” at Prof. Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University, Hyderabad. The event enabled real-time interaction with farmers statewide via the Rythu Vedika video conferencing platform. The program was honored by the presence of the Hon’ble Chief Minister Sri A. Revanth Reddy, the Hon’ble Agriculture Minister Sri T. Nageswara Rao, along with senior ministers and officials.



During the program, the **Rythu Bharosa** scheme for the Kharif (Vanakalam) 2025 season was successfully implemented under the supervision of Sri M. Raghunandan Rao, IAS (Agriculture Secretary), and Sri B. Gopi, IAS (Director of Agriculture).



As per the latest update under the **Rythu Bharosa** scheme:

- A total of **₹2,349.83 Crores** has been disbursed to eligible farmers
- **41.25 Lakh farmers** have received financial assistance
- Covering a cultivable area of **39.16 Lakh acres**
- The **first tranche** was credited to farmers holding up to **2 acres of land**.
- **Disbursement for the remaining beneficiaries**, will be completed within the next **9 days**

Rythu Bharosa to be credited to all ryots in nine days: CM

Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy declared the government's resolve to credit ₹9,000 crore as the first instalment of Rythu Bharosa, farmers investment support scheme, within nine days.

The Chief Minister formally started crediting the amounts to farmers by the click of a button on Monday at the Rythu Nestam programme held at the Prof Jayashankar Telangana Agriculture University. The Chief Minister launched video conference facility in 1,034 Rythu Vedikas (farmers platforms) taking the total vedikas with video conference facility, to help farmers interact with officials and experts on crop related issues, to 1,600.

The government disbursed ₹2,349.83 crore on the first day under Rythu

Bharosa scheme, covering 39.16 lakh acres benefitting 41.25 lakh farmers, who hold land extent up to 2 acres. Out of this 24,22,278 farmers held 13,54,387.27 acres (one acre) and 17,02,611 farmers held 25,62,002.04 acres (two acres).

Mr. Revanth Reddy launched a scathing attack on the earlier Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) government, charging it with having pushed the State into a debt trap, claiming that "a century will not be sufficient to recover from the destruction unleashed by the previous government". "They handed over the State with financial crisis," he said. The State was pushed to such a position where it could not implement schemes like student fee reimbursement and farm loan waiver.
