With profound grief and deep sorrow, we share the news of the sudden passing of our most senior officer, Shri K.Radha Krishna, Scientist F & ASIO (State), who left us unexpectedly on the evening of the 20^{th} of September 2025. His departure has created an irreplaceable void in the organization and in the hearts of all who knew him.

Tech Insights

Artificial General Intelligence (AGI)

Artificial General Intelligence (AGI) is a form of artificial intelligence that matches or surpasses human intelligence across a broad range of cognitive tasks. Unlike current artificial intelligence, which is predominantly "narrow AI" confined to specific domains such as image recognition or playing chess, etc. AGI embodies the versatility, adaptability, and general reasoning abilities of humans. Its core traits include the ability to understand, learn and apply its intelligence across a wide range of tasks, similar to human beings.

Key Characteristics

Versatility: An AGI can perform any intellectual task that a human can, including tasks it was not originally trained for. This capability goes beyond today's AI, which excels only in predefined tasks

Adaptability: AGI systems can learn from experience, apply previous knowledge to new scenarios and handle novel or ambiguous problems efficiently, much like humans do

General Understanding: These systems possess the capacity for common sense reasoning, abstraction and transfer of knowledge across domains, adapting to new and unseen situations

Self-Improvement: AGI can autonomously enhance its own skills, strategies, and capabilities over time

Common Sense Reasoning: They would possess a vast understanding of the world, including facts, relationships and social norms, allowing them to reason and make informed decisions

Benefits and Risks

AGI promises transformative applications: it could solve complex problems in healthcare, climate change, logistics and more by applying human-like insight and efficiency at scale. However, the potential risks are significant.

Current Status and Research

AGI is a theoretical concept and a long-term goal of AI research and does not currently exist. While some advanced AI models show early signs of generalization, no system has demonstrated human-level cognitive breadth or adaptability, Achieving AGI is a complex challenge that requires interdisciplinary collaboration and further breakthroughs in areas like neuroscience and cognitive psychology. The field's major players including OpenAI, DeepMind, Google and Meta actively research AGI and invest heavily in research and development to push the boundaries of what's possible with AI.

Potential Applications and Impact

The development of AGI has the potential to revolutionize various aspects of life, from healthcare and education to scientific discovery and problem-solving.
