

NIC Telangana: eOffice training program to 31 Departments in the State Govt. of Telangana as per the directions of Chief Secretary, Government of Telangana

On 30th September 2025, Sri K. Ramakrishna Rao, IAS, Chief Secretary, Government of Telangana, convened a meeting with the IT Secretary, senior officers, and the NIC eOffice team to review the implementation of the eOffice application across all departments of the state. The NIC eOffice team provided a detailed demonstration of the application to the Chief Secretary and Secretaries from various departments.

During the meeting, it was informed that all 36 eOffice instances had been successfully upgraded to Version 7.x and that training for all District Collectorates on the new version had been completed.

On 4th October 2025, the Chief Secretary issued orders to conduct eOffice training programs for 31 departments of the Telangana State Government. The sessions were held at Room No. 33, 6th Floor, Secretariat Building, chaired by Sh. Bhavesh Mishra, Deputy Secretary to Government, Department of ITE&C, and Sh. Bharat Reddy, Joint Director eGoV.
