Rashtriya Karmayogi

Large Scale Janaseva Training Program
For
NIC Telangana Officials



NIC Telangana: The “**Rashtriya Karmayogi – Large Scale Janseva Program**” was conducted in the **6th Floor Conference Hall of the NIC Telangana State Unit for all NIC Telangana officials**. The program aimed to reinforce a spirit of *Seva Bhav*, discipline, and alignment with the larger vision of national development among government officials, as part of **Mission Karmayogi’s** objective to build a competent, future-ready civil service focused on effective public service delivery and an *Atmanirbhar Bharat*.

To ensure effective delivery and active participation, the training was organised in three batches of **34 participants** each, covering a total of **102 NIC Telangana officials** on **26.11.2025**, **29.11.2025** and **03.12.2025**. Each batch was planned as a full-day, in-person workshop to provide participants with sufficient time for reflection, interaction and hands-on activities.

The program commenced with a formal inaugural ceremony of *Deep Prajwalana* during the first batch on 26.11.2025 by **Shri Raynil John, Scientist-F, Shri John Peter, Section Officer and DDO** and **Ms Y. Sreevani, Scientist-E**, in the presence of **Shri Guntuku Prasad, DDG & SIO, NIC Telangana**, who graced the event through VC. He addressed the participants, shared his insights, emphasised the importance of the program, and clearly articulated the initiative's objectives and expectations of government officials in delivering efficient, citizen-centric services.

Each batch was further divided into small teams of three to five members to encourage peer learning, collaboration and experiential participation. Throughout the day, participants engaged in team-based and individual exercises, reflective discussions using practical use cases, and interactive classroom sessions designed to strengthen personal effectiveness, professional commitment and a citizen-first mindset.

The training for each batch followed a two-session format. In the morning session, participants were onboarded to the program through the **iGOT Karmayogi Mobile App**, taken through the Program Introduction, and then completed a pre-program survey. Subsequently, the modules on “**Who is a Rashtriya Karmayogi**” and “**Expanding our Vision of Success and Fulfilment**” were delivered through highly interactive sessions, including team activities, sharing of personal experiences and creating a “**Tree of Fulfilment**” based on stories selected by respective teams.

In the post-lunch session, the modules on “**Creating Karmayogi Moments**” and “**The Rashtriya Karmayogi as a Nation-Builder**” were covered, again supported by group activities and discussions. Participants also worked on building a “**Line of Connect**” between their specific roles/work and the larger goals of their ministry and the nation, enabling them to see clear linkages between daily responsibilities and national development objectives; the program closure for each batch helped participants consolidate their key learnings and begin thinking proactively as contributors to national development.

At the end of the program, all participants were assessed to evaluate their understanding of the modules. Every participant successfully qualified and was awarded the title and **digital certificate** of “**Rashtriya Karmayogi**”, generated in their respective iGOT Karmayogi Portal accounts; the day concluded with a feedback session in which participants shared their reflections and suggestions on the program.

For seamless execution of the program under the guidance of **Shri Raynil John, Scientist-F** and **Training Head**, a team of two coordinators per batch was constituted. With the support of MTS, the training coordinators ensured logistical arrangements, smooth conduct of sessions and appropriate documentation of key moments; the following officers were nominated as **training coordinators** and extended exemplary support to the Master Facilitators:

The program formally concluded with a **Vote of Thanks**, acknowledging the valuable contributions of the Master Facilitators, participants, coordinators, VC team and MTS staff for their wholehearted support and cooperation in making the training program meaningful and impactful.
