

NIC Telangana: ** Capacity Building Workshop on Government Engineering Department (GED) Payment System **

The Mines Informatics Division of NIC Telangana successfully hosted a **half-day training** on **6th January 2026** on the **Government Engineering Department (GED) Payment System** for both state and central engineering departments across Telangana, as part of the eMining software rollout. This initiative aimed to enhance digital payment processes, boost transparency, and ensure smooth online transactions for government engineering works.

During the session, **participants from 54 Engineer-in-Chief offices** were guided through the complete workflow of the GED Payment System. The training began with an overview of system access via **the official Mines and Geology Department, Telangana portal**, followed by detailed steps for **user registration, OTP verification, account setup, and password updates for first-time logins**. Special focus was placed on **secure access and account management procedures**.

The program also covered how to initiate GED payments for government works. Participants learned to enter work details, select mineral types and quantities, and verify payment information. The process of making payments was explained thoroughly, **including bank navigation, choosing payment options, generating NEFT/RTGS slips, and downloading receipts for records and audits**.

Interactive demos and practical guidance helped clarify each step of the payment process. Common transaction issues and best practices for error-free submissions were also addressed to help users operate confidently and efficiently.

Overall, this training equipped department officials with the necessary skills to effectively utilise the GED Payment System. The eMining Team's efforts support Telangana's vision of digital governance by promoting faster, transparent, and accountable payment procedures across departments
