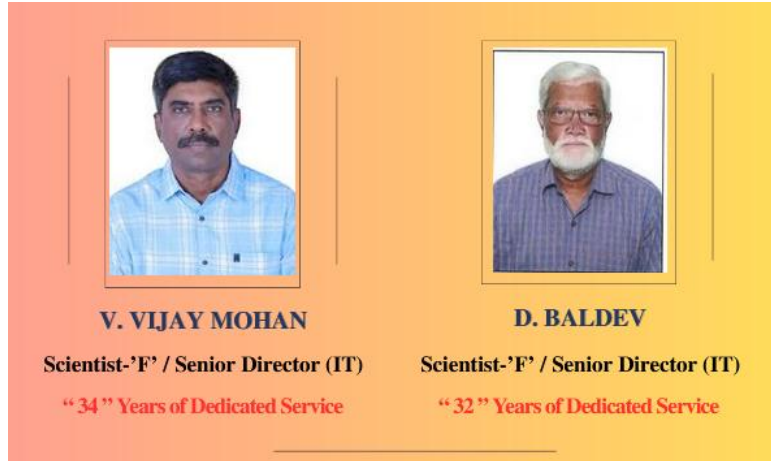


NIC Telangana: ** Superannuation January 2026 - Honouring Excellence and Service**

Profile of Sri D. Baldev, Scientist 'F' / Senior Director (IT)

Sri D. Baldev joined the National Informatics Centre on 28th February 1994 and **rendered 32 years of dedicated service** to the Government of India. A B. Tech graduate in Computer Science & Engineering, he served for over two decades at the **Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), New Delhi**, where he played a pivotal role in managing mission-critical IT systems and developing key applications such as **the ISAAC international anti-corruption portal, CVC Complaint Management System, and pledge portals**. After his tenure at CVC, he **continued to contribute to NIC Telangana, supporting important state projects, including SBTET**. Known for his professionalism, technical expertise, and calm leadership, Shri Baldev earned widespread respect for his commitment to transparency, efficiency, and public service throughout his career.

Profile of Sri V. Vijay Mohan, Scientist 'F' / Senior Director (IT)

Sri V. Vijay Mohan joined NIC in January 1992 and **completed 34 years of exemplary service**, making significant contributions to district, state, and national-level e-Governance initiatives. With an academic background in Applied Mathematics and Computer Applications, he played a **pioneering role in application development at the Chief Minister's Office, Madhya Pradesh, and later in Rangareddy District**, where he **conceptualised and developed PRAJAVANI, which later became a flagship grievance redressal system**. He was a **key contributor to major projects such as PDS, WEBLAND, Dharani, Bhubharathi, election management systems, and ration portability, helping Telangana become the first state in India to implement State Portability in PDS**. His innovative approach, deep domain knowledge, and dedication have left a lasting impact on NIC's e-Governance ecosystem.



Representatives from **AINOA, NIC Telangana, and NICS** also conveyed their best wishes and appreciation, acknowledging the officers' significant role in strengthening the organisation's values and teamwork. Senior officers addressed the gathering, highlighting the professionalism, integrity, and leadership qualities demonstrated by both officers throughout their careers.

A special segment featuring **journey videos and memorable highlights** from their service years added an emotional and reflective touch to the event. Several officers and colleagues from NIC Telangana and District Centres shared their experiences, fond memories, and messages, expressing admiration for the guidance, mentorship, and inspiration provided by the superannuating officers.

The programme also included **messages from family members**, making the event warm and personal. In their addresses, **Sri D. Baldev and Sri V. Vijay Mohan** expressed heartfelt gratitude to the organisation, colleagues, and leadership for the support and cooperation extended to them during their long service in NIC.
