The main goal is to properly implement the **Clinical Establishments Act 2010** by ensuring that all **hospitals, clinics, and healthcare centres** are registered and follow minimum quality standards. This will help improve the overall quality of healthcare services in the state.

A digital system will be created to maintain records of all clinical establishments at the State and District levels. This system will make monitoring easier and more transparent.

It will also help prevent **unqualified practitioners (quacks)** from practicing medicine by making **registration mandatory and strictly monitoring healthcare providers**. This ensures that only qualified and approved professionals offer medical services.

Key Features

- Online registration system for applicants to apply for clinic licenses
- Integrated payment gateway for processing application fees based on different categories
- SMS notifications to keep applicants updated on application status
- Automatic generation of licenses with digital certificates
