

NIC Telangana: Report on Video Conference Support for Nasha Mukt Yuva for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Abhiyan 2026

The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Sri Narendra Modi, on 02.08.2026 inaugurated the 'Nasha Mukt Yuva for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Abhiyan'. Over one crore youths from 28,000 locations nationwide participated in this event. Attendees included Governors of States, Chief Ministers, MY Bharat and National Service Scheme volunteers, as well as participants from schools, colleges, universities, youth clubs, NGOs, and spiritual organisations.

The video conference for the Nasha Mukt Yuva for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Abhiyan 2026 was conducted across ten locations within the state of Telangana. The NIC-Telangana State Centre deployed NIC officers and FMS engineers to these various locations to coordinate and provide the necessary technical support for the successful execution of the event.

Addressing a large nationwide audience via video conference, the Prime Minister elucidated that the campaign extends beyond individual well-being, simultaneously aligning with the broader interests of families, society, and the nation.
