

NIC Telangana: Report on Video Conference Support for The Hon'ble Prime Minister's Interaction under Viksit Vibrant Village Programme – 2026

The **Viksit Vibrant Village Programme – 2026**, officiated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, was held on **26 July 2026**. During the event, the **Hon'ble Prime Minister, Sri Narendra Modi**, participated in a video conference **from New Delhi** with the programme's youth participants. More than **5,000 MY Bharat volunteers from 245 districts across the country** participated in the programme.

This initiative, **organised by MY Bharat under the auspices of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India**, seeks to foster socially responsible young leaders through experiential learning and to promote their contributions towards the vision of **Viksit Bharat–2047**.

Participation from Telangana was facilitated through NIC District Centres

NIC Telangana coordinated the technical aspects of the video conference at various District NIC Centres, with approximately **20 participants at each location**. Interaction of Hyderabad Participant with the Hon'ble Prime Minister

A **notable highlight for Telangana** was the interaction of **Ms Bhavya, representing MY Bharat Kendra, Hyderabad**, with the Hon'ble Prime Minister.

During this interaction, she shared her experience of visiting **Harshil Valley in Uttarkashi**, illustrating how border villages traditionally viewed as the country's last villages are now transforming into its first villages through development initiatives, improved infrastructure, and expanded public services.

The Hon'ble Prime Minister emphasised the significance of travel and experiential learning for personality development and gaining an understanding of the country's diversity. He urged the youth to document their experiences, share them via social media, and inspire more young individuals to participate in similar programmes. He also advised participants to nurture lasting relationships with families in the visited villages to strengthen people-to-people connections and promote national integration.

The youth participants shared insights into developmental initiatives in border villages, including enhancements in roads, electricity, healthcare, digital connectivity, UPI services, and solar power. They also discussed their involvement in cleanliness drives, local governance activities, and voluntary service programmes.

A total of 20 youth from Telangana, including six from Hyderabad district, participated in the Viksit Vibrant Village Programme through the Hyderabad MY Bharat Kendra, joining the Hon'ble Prime Minister's virtual interaction from the Hyderabad District Collectorate.

NIC Coordination

This Video Conference across the NIC District Centres in Telangana was coordinated under the leadership of Sri Guntuku Prasad, Deputy Director General & State Informatics Officer (SIO), NIC Telangana, and Sri Raynil John, Scientist-F and ASIO (Districts) & HoD VC Division, with the support of the respective DIOs, ADIOs, DIAs, and their teams.
