

NIC Telangana: NIC Telangana Supports Digital Transformation of Criminal Justice System

The Telangana State Judicial Academy, Secunderabad, in coordination with Telangana Police, organised a conference on “New Criminal Laws – Strengthening the Criminal Justice System through Digital Platforms”. This conference was inaugurated by the Hon’ble Chief Justice of Telangana High Court, Justice Shri Aparesh Kumar Singh. Hon’ble Justice Moushumi Bhattacharya, Advocate General Shri A. Sudarshan Reddy, Director General of Police Sri. C.V. Anand.



Over 1,200 officers from the Judiciary, Police, Prosecution, Prisons, Forensics, Medical/Health departments, NIC, NCRB and other stakeholders participated in the conference. This conference provided a common platform to deliberate on **digital implementation of the new criminal laws, statutory timelines, scientific and electronic evidence, inter-departmental coordination and challenges in investigation-to-trial workflows.**

NIC Telangana, under the able guidance of Sri Guntuku Prasad (Deputy Director General) and SIO NIC Telangana and Sri G. Srikanth, Sr. Director (IT) and ASIO(State)/HOD, is spearheading the state-level rollout and technical support of these platforms. Sri. Kartik Krishna Vijayasharadhi M, Scientist-D, played a key role in the **state-wide rollout and implementation of the ICJS applications, coordinating with user departments and facilitating training, handholding and technical support.** During the conference, he presented e-Sakshya and Nyaya Shruti, explaining **functionalities & implementation aspects,** and clarified various queries raised by the participating departments.



At the State level, NIC Telangana is facilitating integration and rollout across all pillars of the criminal justice system, enabling seamless information exchange and an interoperable digital ecosystem. These systems include **e-Sakshya**, **e-Summons**, **e-Prosecution**, **e-Forensic**, **MedLEaPR**, **e-Prisons** and **Nyaya Shruti**.

As part of the **Interoperable Criminal Justice System (ICJS)** initiative of the Government of **India**, these key digital platforms have been developed and supported by the **MHA Informatics Division, NIC Headquarters**.
