1. Observance of Human Right's Day

Venue: District Jail, Mamit

3. National Lok Adalat

Venue : District Court, Mamit

Date : 14th December, 2024

On 14th December, 2024, the Mamit District Legal Services Authority Organized National Lok Adalat on 14.12.2024 at District Court, Mamit.

On this day, National Lok Adalat was constituted with one Bench. A total number of 50 cases were taken up before Lok Adalat in which 40 cases were Pre-Litigation and 10 cases were Post Litigation. Out of the total 50 cases, 21 cases were successfully disposed from Pre-Litigation and 10 case was disposed from Post Litigation. Hence, 31 cases with the settlement amount of Rs. 18,25,500/- were disposed.
