### 1) <u>Observance of National Voters Day and Plastic Free</u> awareness.

On 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2025 National Voters Day was observed at DC Conference Hall, Lawngtlai along with District Election Branch Lawngtlai. The programme was attended by approximately 80 people including first time voters and other officials. The main aim of this programme was to educate the importance of voters and how single use plastic had effected the environment.
