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NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/2/2024-P&AR (GSW), Dated Aizawl, the 24th October 2025: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution read with section 28 and sub-section (5) of section 6 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987, the Governor of Mizoram in consultation with the Chief Justice of the Gauhati High Court hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Joint Secretary under Mizoram State Legal Services Authority (MSLSA), Law & Judicial Department, Government of Mizoram, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.-
- (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram State Legal Services Authority (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2025.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Application.- These rules shall Column 1 of the
 - These rules shall apply to the post(s) specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale.-
- The number of the said posts, classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
- Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.-
- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Column 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification.-

No person -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other walld grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of this rule.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Gauhati High Court/the State Government in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officials, so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

Where the Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court-cum-Patron in Chief, MSLSA is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Executive-Chairman, Mizoram State Legal Services Authority relax any of the provisions of these rules to such an extent and subject to such exceptions, as may be deemed necessary.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
