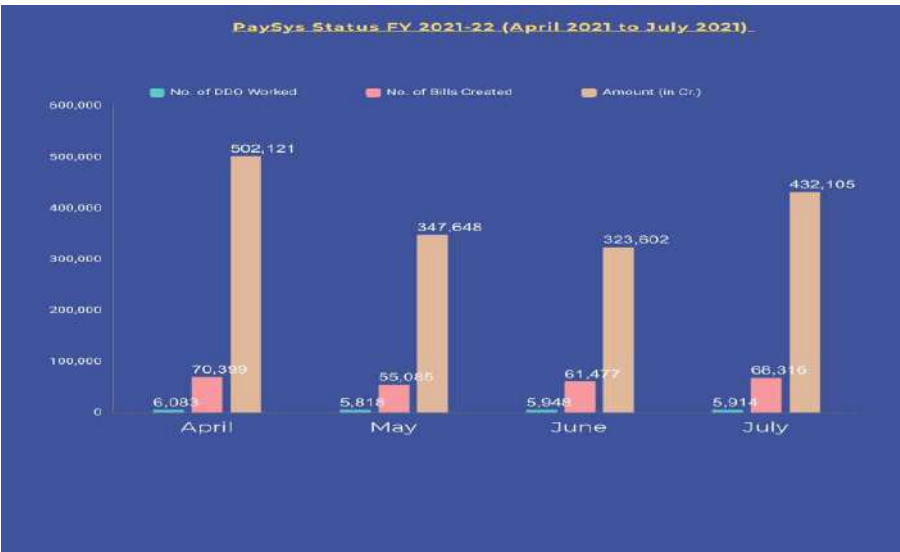

Budget automation has a wide scope in comparison to the manual budgeting process which lacks transparency and is construed with difficulties due to time delay in authorizations, ineffective monitoring and budget control mechanism. The flow of information is very reliable, accurate better monitoring, control and sustainable decision support system for better planning and expenditure audit.

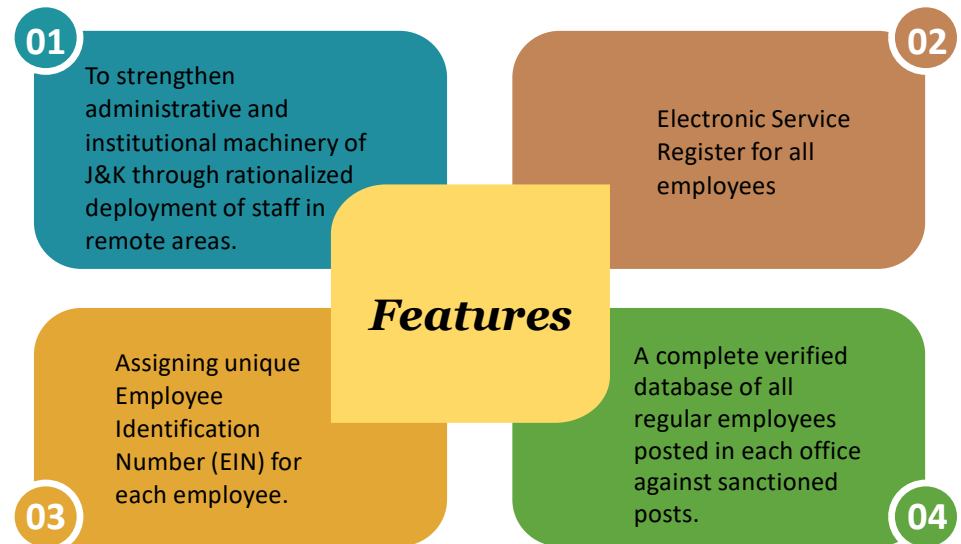

The scope of the project was to capture employee service particulars and assign a unique Employee Identification Number to all the employees for future references. IT Department J&K outsourced the data entry task; NIC provided data entry application and imparted necessary training to the vendor. NIC published the data vide Finance Department Order No. DGAT/Comp-Try/CPIS/467-A/38 dated 28/09/2016.

The National Animal Disease Reporting System (NADRS) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme being implemented by Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries (DADF) through National Informatics Centre. The NADRS involves a computerized network, integrating both MIS and GIS, which links each block, district and the State/UT headquarters in the country to the Central Disease Reporting & Monitoring Unit (CDRMU) in the DADF at New Delhi.

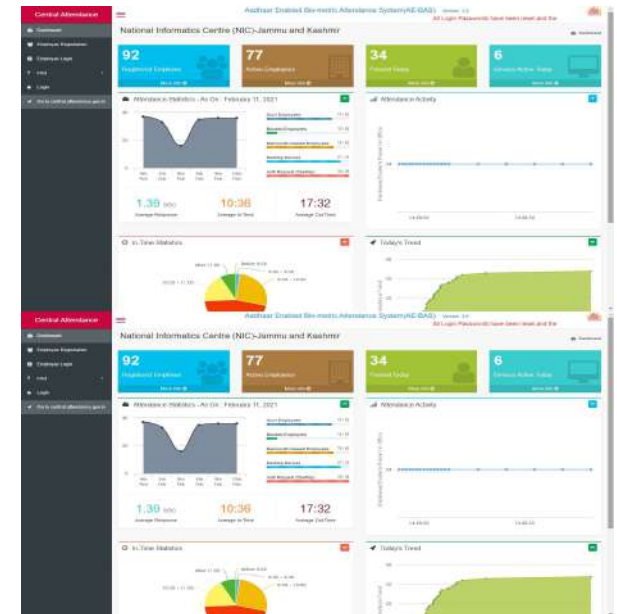

Offices of DG Prison and Jails have been provided Wi Max, connectivity using the NICNET from NIC district offices.

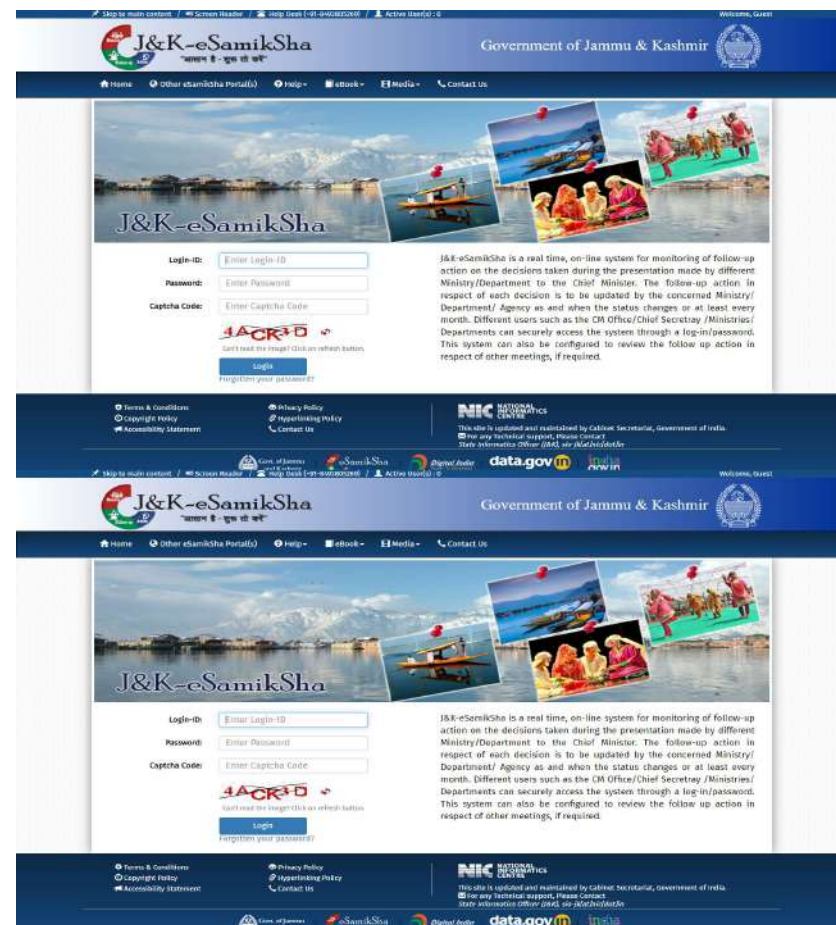

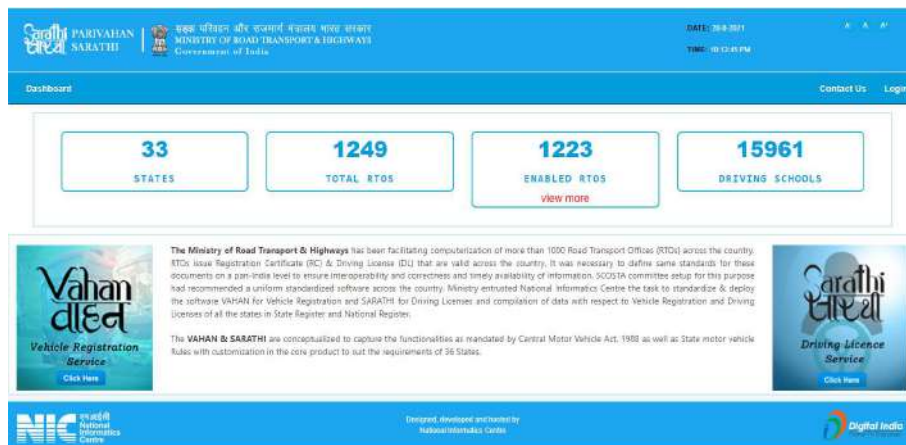

This application has been developed for the J&K Traffic Police with objective to capture the detailed data of Challan imposed by the Traffic Police in the State. Based on the data various reports are generated for the authorities to make decision to control the traffic rule offenders. The software is composed of two modules: Data Capturing for the Challan Officers and MIS for the SSP and IGP. Data porting interface from District office /SSP Office to central servers through NICNET.

System has been implemented in J&K Traffic Police Department and successfully working for last five years in the distributed mode from Jammu as well as Srinagar offices of Traffic Police.

A Web based portal for issuance of Authorization of National Permit is implemented in Both offices of Transport Commissioner of J&K. This portal is integrated with E-banking payment gateway of SBI. Also implemented in 2 offices of Transport Commissioner.
