## India continues to follow trajectory of Steady Decline in Active Cases



National Recovery Rate now at 97.32%, amongst highest in the world



No new fatality in 17 States/UTs; No new cases in 6 States/UTs in the last 24 hours

More than 87 lakh beneficiaries vaccinated against COVID-19

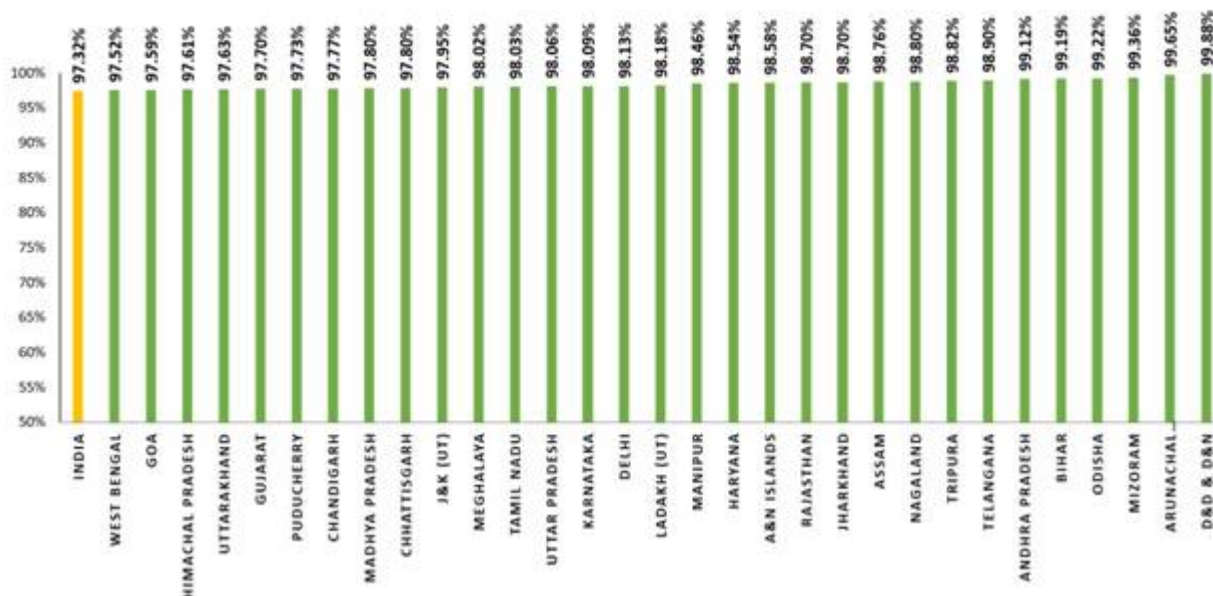
The Active Cases in the country are showing a consistent decline. India's total Active Caseload has dropped to **1.36 lakh (1,36,872)** today.

The present active caseload now consists of just **1.25%** of India's total Positive Cases.

More than **1.06 Cr (1,06,33,025)** people have recovered so far. **11,805** patients have recovered and got discharged in the last 24 hours. India's **Recovery Rate of 97.32%** is amongst the highest in the world. The difference between the recovered and active cases has further increased to 1,04,96,153 today.

In another positive development, **31 States/UTs** have reported Recovery Rate **more than the national average**. Daman & Diu & Dadra & Nagar Haveli have a recovery rate of 99.88%.

## 31 States & UTs have Recovery Rate more than the national average



**Seventeen States/UTs** reported **no deaths** in the last 24 hours. These are Lakshadweep, Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Gujarat, Chandigarh, J&K (UT), Meghalaya, Ladakh (UT), Manipur, Haryana, A&N Islands, Rajasthan, Nagaland, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh and D&D & D&N.

Also, **6 States/UTs** have reported **no new cases** in the last 24 hours. These are Sikkim, Meghalaya, A&N Islands, Nagaland, Tripura and D&D & D&N.

As on 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2021, till 8:00 AM, the cumulative number of healthcare and frontline workers vaccinated against COVID19 in the country has **surpassed 87 lakhs**. The countrywide vaccination drive was launched by the Hon. Prime Minister on 16<sup>th</sup> Jan 2021.

**87,20,822 beneficiaries** have been vaccinated through **1,84,303 sessions**, as per the provisional report till 8 am today. These include **61,07,120 HCWs (1st dose)**, **1,60,291 HCWs (2nd dose)** and **24,53,411 FLWs (1<sup>st</sup> dose)**.

As on Day-31 of the vaccination drive (15<sup>th</sup> February, 2021), a total of **4,35,527** beneficiaries were administered the vaccine. Out of which, **2,99,797** beneficiaries were vaccinated across **10,574** sessions for the first dose and **1,35,730** HCWs received the second dose of vaccine.

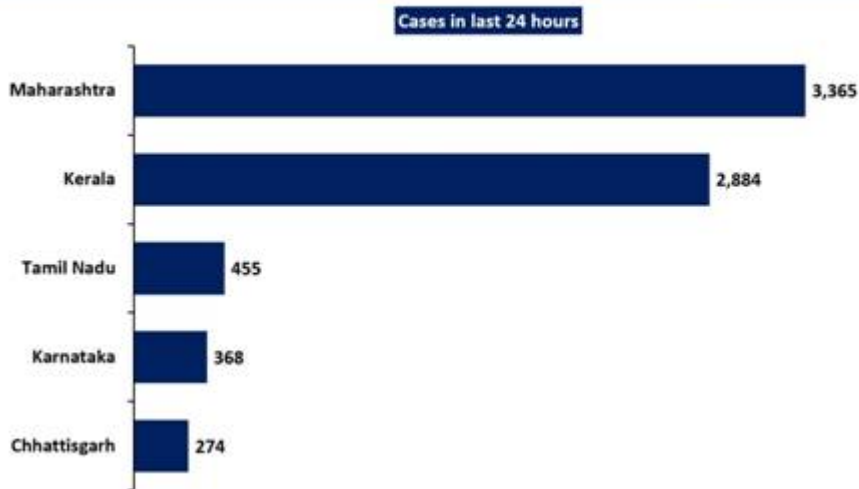
**f** 9,121 new cases were recorded in the last 24 hours.

**80.54% of the new cases** are from 5 States.

**t** Maharashtra reported the highest daily new cases at 3,365. It is followed by Kerala with 2,884, while Tamil Nadu reported 455 new cases.



### 81% of new cases reported in only 5 States

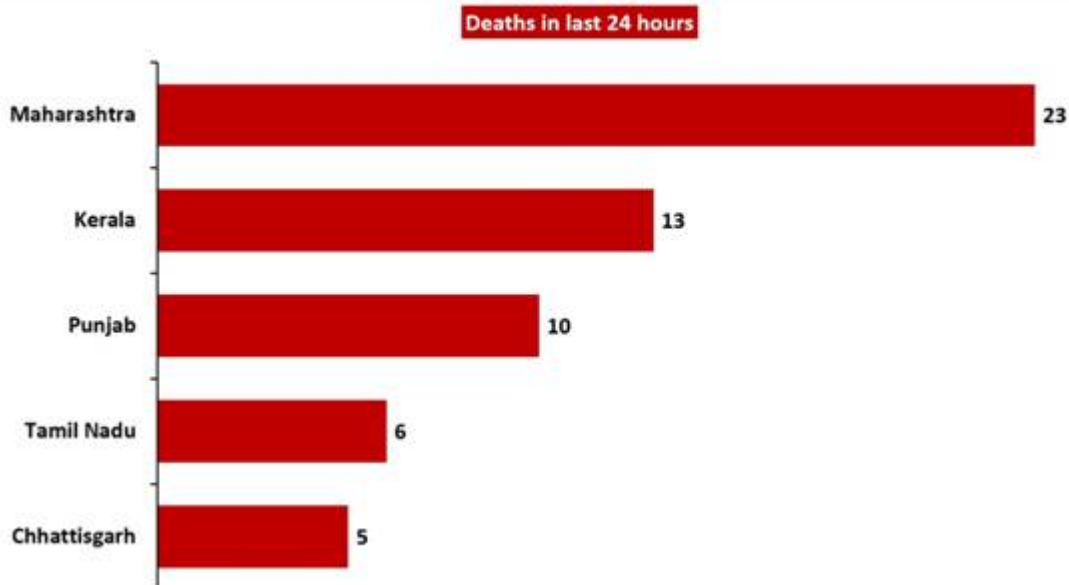


**81 deaths** were reported in the last 24 hours.

Five States account for **70.37%** of the new deaths.

Maharashtra saw the maximum casualties (23). Kerala follows with 13 daily deaths and Punjab has reported 10 new deaths.
